 - (iii) The three key elements in the definition of motivation are effort, organizational goals, and needs.
 - (iv) Job descriptions and specifications are created from information gathered in interviews with job applicants.
 - (v) The classical view of unity of command suggests that subordinates should have only one superior to whom they report.
 - (vi) When decisions tend to be made at lower levels in an organization, the organization is said to be decentralized.
 - (vii) Decentralization describes the degree to which decision making is concentrated at a single point in the organization.
 - (viii) Recruitment is the process of locating, identifying, and attracting capable applicants.
