With respect to the evaluation methodology of Basis and MLISc programmes, it was explained by the Director that there has been a crepancy in what was approved in the Academic Council and what was being priced in the Programme Guides unto 1997. A large number of students have made presentations to the university for declaration of their results on the basis of the information provided in the programme guides. After discussion, the School Board resolved that the results of the students up to 1997 batch should be declared as per the apprisions mentioned in the respective programme guides of these two courses i.e.

Item 18.3.5

The School Board approved the launching of MLISc programme in Hindi medium. However, it was suggested to the faculty to work out the modalities and a timeframe for the same.

The School Board approved in principle the proposal of a Diploma Programme in Indian Society and Culture at Home and Abroad suggested by the faculty of Sociology.

Item 18.6.1

The School Board approved the proposal for permitting MLISc students to write their assignments and examination in Hindi medium.

Item 18.7.1

The School Board discussed at length the proposal from the Discipline of Political Science seeking approval of revision and re-writing of FHS-1 which had been done for international students. The School Board resolved that the proposal be first discussed in the School Council and then brought to the School Board again.

Item 18.8.1

Prof. S D Muni was earlier co-opted as a member of the School Board under Clause 2-E of Statute 10-A. He has left for abroad and hence the School Board resolved to co-opt Prof. S N Jha for the same.

Item 18.8.2

The School Board approved the eligibility criteria for admission to BLISc programme as approved by the Distance Education Council which is as follows:

- Second Class graduate with 50% marks, Or
- Graduate with Diploma in Library Science, Or
- Graduate with 2 ; years of working experience in Library & Inf. Sciences, Or
- Bachelor Degree in a Professional Area (Engineering, Pharmacy, Law, etc.)
