24.3.2 The Committee, after going through the vacancy positions presented, observed that many of the Disciplines had projected lesser number of seats, compared to the existing number of Ph D seats and eligible faculty members as research supervisors available with them, while some of the disciplines had projected all vacancies.

Responding to queries of the committee whether the Disciplines had given any reasoning about the lesser number of seats projection, the Member Secretary informed that some disciplines / Schools were asked to give reasons for lesser projection of seats to which they responded that they would be pre-occupied with preparing/revising for other ODL programmes. The member secretary also informed that the Research Unit had asked every school to give faculty wise existing research scholars, vacant seats and seats they wish to advertise which were presented in
