The chairperson welcomed all the members to its 25th School Board meeting. Further, the chairperson informed that she received five representations from the members of the School Board regarding non-faithful recording of the minutes relating to the item no. SB 24.5.1 She explained the reason for this and informed the members about the technical problems in the proposal itself. The board members discussed this matter & decided that the minutes be recorded faithfully & the issues related to this aspect be discussed separately.

SB 25.1.1

As per above discussion the minutes of the last School Board (25th) meeting held on 28th March, 2000 were confirmed, with the addition that the NCMCH programme was approved in principle.

SB 25.2.1

The list of the thrust areas and the list of supervisors of Ph. D (Phase-I) Programme was approved with the corrections in Pol. Science Discipline that Dr. Anurag Joshi's name may be added in the list of supervisors and in the thrust areas 'Developmental Studies' may be read as 'Developmental politics'.

SB 25.3.1

The Programme in M.A. History was approved with the observation that the suggestions made by the members may be incorporated in the programme.

SB 25.3.2

The Diploma in Environmental Studies was approved by the Board.

SB 25.3.3

The change in the courses of MTM from Management of Marketing Communication and Advertising (MS-68) to Managing Entrepreneurship and Small Business in Tourism as MTM-08 was accepted as a reporting item.

SB 25.4.1

The introduction of a new elective course for BDP (Economics) on Industrial Development in India was approved and it was requested that the faculty should take note of the suggestions made here and incorporate them.

SB 25.5.1


The certificate programme in Participatory Management of Displacement, Resettlement and Rehabilitation submitted by Sociology and Economics Disciplines was approved.

SB 25.6.1

The issue of constituting a programme Expert Committee was discussed in the School Board. The Director informed that at present, the School follows a uniform policy in this matter.

A member raised the point that the matter relating to technical irregularity in the NCMCH programme proposal may now be discussed under any other matter. Another member however suggested that the matter may be taken up only after the Experts Committee (proposed to be constituted) has completed its work.
