The Chairman placed on record sincere appreciation for the contributions and guidance of the outgoing members, Dr. E. Vayunandan, Dr. Abha Singh, Dr. Neena Talwar Kanungo, Dr. Jaswant Sokhi, Dr. Srilatha, Dr. Eisha Kannadi and Ms. B. Kiranmayi.

The following items on the Agenda were deliberated.

- SB 37.1 Confirmation of the minutes of the 36th—eeting of the School Board of SOSS held on May 27, 2005.
- SB 37.1.1 It was informed by the Chairman that the Minutes of the 36th meeting were circulated to all members. Since no comments have been received, the Chairman proposed that the Minutes may be deemed to be confirmed.
- SB 37.1.2 The Board confirmed the Minutes/of the 36th School Board Meeting, as circulated (Annexure-1).
- SB 37.2 To seek approval of the School Board for revised Preparatory Course in Social Sciences (PSS-01)
- SB 37.2.1 The Chairman informed that in the 36th Meeting, the Board had approved in principle the proposal/to revise Preparatory Course in Social Science. Dr. Neeta Mathur, BPP/Coordinator, was requested to convene a meeting of the internal faculty/members to finalise the course contents.
- SB 37.2.2 The Chairman informed that the meetings of the Committee comprising Prof. Pardeep Sahni, Prof. Kapil Kumar, Prof. A.R.Khan, Prof. A.S. Narang, Dr. Kaustuva Barik and Dr. Neeta Mathur were held to frame the contents of the/Preparatory Course in Social Sciences.
- SB 37.2.3 The School Board deliberated on the contents of the course and approved the same (Annexure2). The Board recommended that the course contents should be submitted to the SCAC for consideration and approval.
- SB 37.3 To consider the progress report of Ms. Latha, Ph.D. student in Library and Information Science for the period July-December 2004 and Sh. Pardeep Rai, Ph. D. student in Library and Information Science for the period January-June 2005
- SB 37.3.1 The Board considered the progress report of Ms. Latha.
- SB 37.3.2 The Board approved the same and recommended that it be forwarded to the Research Council, for further necessary action (Annexure-3).

- Regarding the progress report of Sh. Pardeep Rai, Ph.Er student in Library and Information Science, for the period January-June 2005, the Chairman SB 37.3.3 informed that in the 36th Meeting of the School Boara, it was decided that the candidate should be asked to reframe the questionnaire. The Board had further recommended that the Discipline Coordinator, Library & Information Science should convey the observations of the School Board to the candidate and to the Research Guide for/the needful to be done and to resubmit the questionnaire.
 - The Board recommended that Director, SOSS, should convey the observations of the School Board (36th Meeting) to the candidate and to the Research Guide for reframing the questionnaire and resubmitting the SB 37.3.4 same for consideration by the School Board and if approved by the School Board in its next meeting, the candidate should be asked to make necessary changes in the Chapters already prepared.
 - The Chairman informed that the progress report for the period January-June 2005 states that the candidate has submitted the draft of the 5th SB 37.3.5 Chapter of the thesis to the Supervisor.
 - The Board considered the progress report for the period January-June 2005 (Annexure-4) and recommended that it should be forwarded to the SB 37.3.6 Research Council with the observation at 37.3.4 above.

'Research Methods in Economics (MEC-009)' in the 2nd Year of M.A. Programme.

- SB 37.6.2 The course contents of MEC-009 framed in the Expert Committee meeting were placed before the School Board for consideration.
- SB 37.6.3 The Board deliberated on the course contents and approved the same on the basis of the recommendations of the Expert Committee (Annexure-7). The Board recommended that the course contents should be submitted for consideration and approval by the SCAC.
- SB 37.7 To report the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor for launch of M.A (Public Policy) programme for IAS Probationers
- SB 37.7.1 The Chairman informed that the School Board in its 36th Meeting had approved the Phase-I Form for M.A. (Public Policy) Programme exclusively for IAS Probationers on training for two years with Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA), Mussoorie.
- SB 37.7.2 The Chairman informed that the 64 Credit M.A (Public Policy)
 Programme has the following 7 Courses of 8 Credits each and 2 Projects of 4 Credits each.

- SB 37.7.4 The Chairman informed that the University has signed an MoU with LBSNAA on 29th August 2005 for the launch of M.A. (Public Policy) with effect from 2005-06 admission cycle. The Board was further I informed that the Phase-II Form has already been approved by the Academic Programme Commttee in its meeting held on 8th September 2005.

- SB 37.7.6 The Board, while considering and approving the Programme Structure and contents of the course (Annexure-8), placed on record its deep sense of appreciation for launching this Programme. The Board recommended that the Programme Structure and Contents should be submitted to SCAC for information and further necessary action.
