To confirm the Minutes of the 47th Meeting of the School Board held on 8th SB 48.1 March 2010. The Board confirmed the Minutes of the 47th School Board Meeting as SB 48.1.1. circulated. To approve the Minutes of the meetings of eighth Standing Committee on SB 48.2 Research Programme held on 12th April 2010. The recommendations of the Standing Committee were placed for SB 48.2.1 consideration of the School Board. (Annexure 1) The Board approved the Minutes of the Standing Committee Meeting and SB 48.2.2 recommended it to be forwarded to the Research Unit for approval of the Research Council. To consider and approve the revised Phase-1 and Phase-3 forms of three SB 48.3 programmes, viz., M.Sc. in Actuarial Economics, M.Sc., in Environmental Economics and M.Sc. in Applied Quantitative Finance After detailed deliberation on the revised proposal submitted by the SB 48.3.1 Discipline of Economics, the Board approved the Programmes, viz., M.Sc. in Actuarial Economics, M.Sc., in Environmental Economics and M.Sc. in Applied Quantitative Finance to be launched in dual mode, face-to-face and However, the Board felt that running the Programme under face-to-face mode must be permissible as per IGNOU's Acts and Statutes and clarification may be sought in this regard. Two letters received from MHRD in this regard were brought to the notice of the Board by some members. Further the Programme Coordinator was requested to withdraw the term 'Self-financing Scheme' from the proposal and also to ensure that no franchising is done by MSE (Madras School of Economics) regarding these programmes. It was recommended that the programme fee should be the same for running the programmes from IGNOU as well as MSE. (Annexure 2) To consider and approve the Bio-data for empanelment of Evaluators for SB 48.4 various Disciplines received from various Regional Centres The list of evaluators received from Regional Centres and duly approved by SB 48.4.1 the concerned disciplines were placed for consideration in the School Board. To Consider and approve the list of Paper Setters/Evaluators/Moderators SB 48.7 for M.Phil/Ph.D Programme for all the six courses in Library and Information Science The School Board recommended the list of Paper Setters, Moderators and SB 48.7.1 Evaluators for various courses of M.Phil/Ph.D Programme in Library and Information Science. 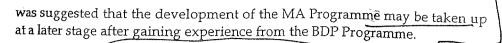

- SB 48.11 To consider and approve the proposal for activating a scheme of Research Funding for Teaching Faculty
- The Faculty of History has in a Discipline Meeting held on 9th April 2010 resolved to request the University to activate a Scheme of Research Funding for all the members of the teaching faculty according to which a grant of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) shall be made available to each member of the teaching faculty for a period two years for the purposes of undertaking field work for the furtherance of her/his research work, attending national and international seminars/conferences etc., purchase of books and journals and stationery and for such other contingent purposes as arise in the course of her/his research work.

The School Board approved the proposal and requested the History Discipline to furnish the details of the Scheme before forwarding the proposal for consideration by the University authorities.

- SB 48.12 To consider and approve the proposal for implementing the Scheme of granting Fellowship to all Ph.D students
- The members were informed that the proposal was earlier approved by the School Board and the decision is pending at Research Unit. The Board reiterated that the University should implement the scheme of granting fellow ship of the value of Rs.8,000/- (Rs. Eight Thousand only) to all full-time Ph.D. students. The fellow ship of this kind is already operational in all the Central Universities.
