soss 6.1.1 The Board confirmed the minutes of the fifth meeting of the School Board after considering the amendment made in Item 5.2.2 (ii) which would now read as 'Legal Entitlements and Their Implementation' and with regard to item No. 5.7.2 which would now read as 'Dr. Kapil Kumar placed on record that the resolution of the Academic Council, Board of Management, Planning Board etc. which are related to the School and Academic courses be circulated to the members of the School Board."



ITEM NO. 7; ANY OTHER ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR SOSS 6.7.1 Prof. B. Chattopadhyay presented a note with regard to the following:

- a) Economics should be treated as a subject belonging both to the Natural Sciences and Social Sciences.
- b) There is an urgent need to launch a Programme of Refresher Course for the Counsellors and the number of counselling sessions should increase to at least 25 sessions per Course (20) for the main and 5 for the appendices).
- c) He further suggested that in order to resolve the problem of high standards in Course materials, two separate streams of students, one to do major in Economics and another willing to clear only 16 credits in Economics in BDF, be encouraged.

Interacting on the points raised by Prof. B. Chattopadhyay, Prof. A.K. Bagchi opined that one way of resolving the problem of high standards in Economics education could be to have the best teachers in the country recorded in Audio/Video cassettes on various topics included in the syllabii. Once these are produced, such Audio-Video modules can help both the counsellors & the students in this direction.
