National Workshop on Research Methodology in Performing and Visual Arts

Research is a systematic plan to determine, find or interpret new facts and add new knowledge for conducting research. School of Performing and Visual Arts is offering Ph. D in Performing & Visual Arts with specialization in Fine Arts, Music and Theatre Arts and M. Phil in Theatre Arts since 2011. To address issues related to Performing and Visual Arts a four day National Workshop on Research Methodology in Performing and Visual Arts was organized by the school from 2nd November to 5th November 2015. 70 participants from all over India including scholars, teachers and professionals attended the workshop.

The Vice-Chancellor Prof. Nageshwar Rao inaugurated the National Workshop in presence of Pro Vice-Chancellor Prof. Sushma Yadav, Prof. Sunil Kumar, Dr. G. Bharadwaza (Director, SOPVA) and IGNOU fraternity at the Convention Centre. The Inaugural session commenced with lighting the sacred lamp by invitees. On this occasion the proceeding of National Seminar held in January 2014 consisting selected papers published by IGNOU was also released.

The workshop extended till evening by lecture cum demonstration and lives performances.
