The University

The Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), was established by an Act of Parliament, Government of India in 1985. The University serves the educational aspirations of over 27 Lakh students in India and 43 other countries through the network of 67 Regional Centres, more than 3,000 Learner Support Centres and 67 overseas Partner Institutions. In order to serve Distance Learners of Central Coastal Andhra and Rayalaseema Districts, the University has established a Regional Centre at Vijayawada and Sub-Regional Centre at Tirupati.

Recognition of IGNOU Degrees: IGNOU is a Central University created by an Act of Parliament and all Certificates, Diplomas and Degrees awarded by the University are at par with all such degrees issued by other Universities under the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as per the University Grants Commissions (UGC) circular no. F.1-52/2000 (CPP-II) dated May 5, 2004 and AIU circular no. EV/II/(449/94/176915-177915, dated January 14, 1994) and AICTE circular no. AICTE/academic/Nov. Dec. 2005, dated May 13, 2005. B.Ed. programme offered by the IGNOU is also recognised by the NCTE.

Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) Programme of IGNOU aims at developing the understanding and competencies required by practising teachers for effective teaching-learning process at the secondary stage. The programme also provides opportunities of sharing experiences gained by practising teachers. It enables in-service teachers to select and organize learning experiences according to the requirement of learners. In addition, it provides knowledge and develops in them an understanding of areas such as educational evaluation, school management, etc.

Programme Objectives

- To systematize experiences and strengthen the professional competencies of in-service teachers.
- To imbibe knowledge and develop an understanding of the various methods and approaches of organizing learning experiences of secondary school students.
- To develop skills required in selecting and organizing learning experiences.
- To understand the nature of the learning process.
- To develop skills involved in dealing with the academic and personal problems of learners.
- To acquire knowledge and develop an understanding of the various procedures and techniques of evaluation and their classroom applications.
- To develop skills involved in selecting, developing and using evaluation tools.
- To acquire knowledge and develop an understanding of various aspects of school management.
- To develop competencies for organizing various instructional and student support activities.
- To develop an appreciation of the role of the teacher in the prevailing socio-cultural and political system in general and the educational system in particular.

Eligibility:

- 1. Graduation or Post-Graduation Degree with fifty per cent marks: Provided that the requirement of fifty per cent marks shall not apply to persons appointed as teachers prior to the commencement of the National Council for Teacher Education (Regulations Norms and Procedure) Second Amendment Regulations, 30.3.2010 and Gazette Notification dt. 26.7.2010.
- 2. Two years' full time teaching experience on temporary/permanent basis as Primary/ Graduate/ Post Graduate teacher in a primary, secondary/higher/senior secondary school with registration number recognised by the respective Directorate of Education or Central or State Government or Union Territory. The teacher should be in service at the time of submitting application form as well as at the time of producing the original documents at the Regional Centre. The experience certificate should be issued by the Principal or Headmaster/ Headmistress only. The requisite teaching experience of two years must be completed on or before the last date of submission of application as notified in the advertisement. An attested photocopy of the Recognition and Affiliation Certificate with Registration number issued to the school, Central or a State Government or Union Territory or Directorate of Education must be enclosed at the time of submission of Entrance cum admission form.
- 3. The reservation for SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy Layer) and other categories shall be per the rules of the Central Government. There shall be relaxation of five percent marks in favour of SC/ST/ Kashmiri Migrant and other categories of candidates, if any, as per Govt. of India Rules.

- 4. The candidate should submit their application form only at the concerned Regional Centre under whose jurisdiction/ operational area the working school falls.
- 5. Masters' Degree awarded without a first degree is not accepted for purpose of Academic Studies in IGNOU.
- 6. Government of India Notification dated 7th March, 2013, will be followed for allowing concession for the wards of Kashmiri migrants for admission during academic session 2013-14.

JURISDICTION: Only candidates from the districts of Krishna, Guntur, Khammam, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Kurnool and Anantapur are eligible to apply under the Regional Centre, Vijayawada.

Admission cycle : The University offers B.Ed. in January Session only through Entrance Test.
