
- Copy of the Application form / Admit Card of Entrance Test

- Graduation and Post-Graduation Mark Sheets and Certificates.
- In case of JRF candidates bring your JRF award letter which will be checked for proof of your exemption from Ph.D. Entrance Test. The validity of the Fellowship awarded to you must be within the permissible limit as stipulated in the award letter, by that regulatory body.
- For *Category B candidates* (Entrance Test), proof of having cleared UGC-NET/UGC- CSIR NET and similar National level tests
- Caste Certificate, wherever necessary.
- NOC from concerned organization in case of candidates already in employment

Please note:

- 1 The Ph.D. Programme is a regular full-time / part time (for employed candidates) and supervisors will guide selected candidates at IGNOU Headquarter, New Delhi.
- 2 As per the UGC Guidelines, all the selected candidates will be required to do course work equivalent to one semester at the IGNOU headquarter, New Delhi. The classes for coursework will be held at headquarter and thereupon they will present their progress reports at IGNOU headquarter in New Delhi.
- 3 University will not provide any accommodation for you during your Ph.D. You have to make your own arrangements.
- 4 You must be on time on the day of the interview
- 5 Please acknowledge this mail and confirm your attendance.

Annexure 1

Guidelines for Development of Proposal

We give below the main components of a research proposal as is generally expected by our decision taking bodies, viz. Doctoral Committee, School Board, SOCE. It should contain the following:

(1) Title. Give proposed Research Title.

(2) Introduction Give a broad description of proposed Research Work. Explain important concepts in the study (use more space if needed).

(3) Objectives /Aim/ Hypothesis of the study.

(4) Review of Literature. Review some important and related Published Works and analyze them in the context of your study (use more space if needed).

(5) Methodology : Provide a detail description of research design, setting of the study, sample, sample size, sampling techniques and Tools and Techniques - you propose to use (use more space if needed).

(6) Bibliography Selected list of references used and proposed for the study should be mentioned (use more space if needed).

Note : The Research Proposal should be between 3000-5000 words. You may submit the proposal before your interview.
