The programme shall impart knowledge and proficiency in agriculture value chain and supply chain management. The School of Agriculture is proposing to jointly develop the Diploma in Agricultural Cost Management programme with the Institute of cost Accountants of India (ICMAI). An MoU for the purpose has been signed on 26 <sup>th</sup> April 2023. The Programme will be of 40 credits with 6 theory courses. The minimum eligibility for the programme shall be 12 <sup>th</sup> pass in any discipline.
	The programme will be offered through the Learner Support Centers (LSCs) of IGNOU and Chapters of ICMAI. The cost of delivery at ICMAI chapters will be borne by IGNOU as per the IGNOU norms. The fees collected will remain with IGNOU. However, the revenue sharing will be reviewed after five years.


