The following the agenda items were taken up for discussion as mentioned below:

# 70.1 To consider and approve the Minutes of 69<sup>th</sup> School Board Meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2019 and to note the actions taken thereon.

Chairperson, presented the Minutes of 69<sup>th</sup> Meeting of School Board held on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2019. Observation of Dr.Reeta Devi, Programme Co-ordinator of CHBHC Programme vide item No.69.3.2 was discussed as follows:

- There is no minimum eligibility criteria for students to be admitted to IGNOU as per existing policy.
- Academic Co-ordination Division (ACD) has clarified that additional two credits without significant change in content would be considered as minor revision.
- O As eligibility criteria of CHBHC Programme is 10<sup>th</sup> pass and that of CHHA is 10+2, merger of both programmes does not arise.
- O Academic Counsellors will be at Post Graduation level as approved by ACSC. However, practical component could be done with Counsellors having graduation degree.

### 70.2 To consider and approve Minutes of the Doctoral Committee of Ph.D in Nursing

Doctoral Committee Minutes of Ph.D in Nursing was approved with the observations as noted below:

### 70.2.1 Pre-submission seminar of Ms. Laxmi, Ph.D. in Nursing Scholar:

Presubmission seminar presentation of Ms.Laxmi as mentioned in the Doctoral Committee was recommended by School Board for approval by the Research Council.

### 70.2.2 Progress Report of eleven Ph.D. in Nursing Scholars

Progress Report of eleven Ph.D scholars as mentioned in the Minutes of Doctoral Committee was recommended by the School Board for approval by Research Council. However, it was observed that Progress report should mention 'recommendation' of the Doctoral Committee against each scholar instead of using word 'approved'.

Modification of Problem Statement of Ms.Rimple Sharma (enrl. No.173102104) was recommended for approval of Research Council.

### 70.2.3 Modification in Problem Statement of Mr. Vikas Bhaskar, Ph.D. in Nursing Scholar (Enrl. No. 173102150)

Problem Statement of Mr. Vikas Bhaskar was further modified by school Board as follows.

"A study to assess the knowledge, Competence, level of satisfaction and barriers perceived by Community Health Officers (CHO) and beneficiary feedback regarding management of non-communicable diseases in Health and Wellness Centres of Uttar Pradesh"

Members also proposed that the research Supervisors should ensure the future Research topics to have short tiltes.

### 70.2.4 Bio-Data of Dr.Neerja Sood for considering as Supervisor for Ph.D in Nursing

Bio-Data of Dr.Neerja Sood for consideration as Supervisor for Ph.D in Nursing was discussed in the light of the existing IGNOU guidelines vis-a-vis UGC 2016 regulations. It was unanimously agreed that the Bio-data of Dr.Neerja Sood, Assistant Professor in Nursing, fulfills the criteria for Research Supervisor for Ph.D in Nursing in the field of Public Health Specialization.

School Board recommended name of Dr.Neerja Sood for approval by the Research Council.

### 70.3 To consider and approve List of Evaluators for evaluating Ph.D thesis of Mrs. Laxmi, Enrl No. 131636630

Prof.T.K.Jena, Director, SOHS read out the panel of names of seven (7) evaluators provided by Prof.Bimla Kapoor, Supervisor of Mrs. Laxmi, Enrl No.131636630 towards the evaluation of her Ph.D thesis.

No observation was received from any of the members and the panel of names of the seven (7) evaluators were recommended by the School Board Members for approval in the Research Council.

### 70.4 To consider and approve Programme Revision Form (PRF) for the Minor Revision of CHBHC Programme

Dr.Reeta Devi presented the Programme Revision Form (PRF) for CHBHC Programme in which she proposed addition of two credits to the existing 14 credits. She also mentioned that the content would undergo minor change in the form of two additional units which would constitute

less than 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the total content. ACD has already confirmed the quantum of revision to be considered as minor in nature.

In the light of the observations given by ACD, the School Board approved the Programme Revision Form for minor revision of the CHBHC Programme.

# 70.5 To consider and approve implementation model for the Post Graduate Certificate in Medical Management of CBRNE Disasters (PGCMDM) Programme

Dr. Biplab Jamatia presented the implementation strategy for PGCMDM Programme on behalf of Prof.Ruchika Kuba, Programme Co-ordinator. The following points were highlighted:

- All students will be required to visit INMAS for a period of 10 days before starting their counselling sessions in the respective learner support centres. There will be practical sessions for 8 days and theory counselling sessions of two days. INMAS will be designated as a skill development centre attached to all the active LSCs.
- The student counsellor ratio for demonstration activities and theory counselling will be
   1:30. The ratio for hands-on-training for group exercises will be
   5.
- In addition to the counsellors in the Learner Support Centre (LSC), there will be a local pool of counsellors and a national pool of counsellors. These counsellors could also be invited to take the counselling sessions.
- All the counsellors will be required to undergo a face-to-face orientation training programme after their appointment which would be organized jointly by IGNOU and INMAS

After detailed deliberations, Programme implementation strategy of PGCMDM Programme was approved by the School Board.

## 70.6 To consider and approve the Implementation Strategy for the Certificate Programme in Yoga (CPY)

Dr.Biplab Jamatia, Programme Co-ordinator presented the implementation strategy for Certificate Programme in Yoga which has been launched in July, 2019. He presented a detailed sessionwise plan for practical component of Yoga Programme that would be implemented in two spells of six days each. He clarified that practical activities would be carried out in traditional Yoga Centres where a minimum of two regular Yoga Demonstrators are available.

- The Counsellor student ratio will be 1:10 to 1:20 depending upon the facilities available.
- The Yoga Centres will act as Skill Development Centres which will be attached to regular Study Centres of IGNOU.
- The Yoga Counsellors possessing atleast the level-1 Certification by Yoga Certificate Board would be considered as evaluators.

Dr.Biplab further informed that with the approval of competent authority, programme fee has been reduced to Rs.5,000/- for July, 2019 session.

After deliberations, it was agreed that the proposed model would be applicable to the pilot batch of students which could be reviewed for future batches if needed.

With the above observation, implementation strategy was approved by the School Board.

# 70.7 Reporting of Post Graduate Certificate in Accupuncture (PGCACP) Programme kept in abeyance from July, 2019 session

Prof.T.K.Jena, Director, SOHS informed the members that the Post Graduate Certificate in Accupuncture (PGCACP) Programme was kept in abeyance with effect from July, 2019 session. The admission fee of those admitted in July, 2019 session would be refunded back.

# 70.8 To consider and approve the additional list of Course Writers/Editors, Paper setters/ Moderators for the following Programmes of SOHS

- 70.8.1 Post Graduate Certificate in Medical Management of CBRNE Disasters (PGCMDM)
- 70.8.2 Diploma in Nursing Administration (DNA)
- 70.8.3 Certificate Programme in Yoga (CPY)

Dr. Biplab Jamatia, on behalf of Prof.Ruchika Kuba, Programem Co-ordinator, presented the list of five names of Course Writers/Editors, Paper Setters/Moderators for the Post Graduate Certificate in Medical Management of CBRNE Disasters (PGCMDM) Programme, and the same was approved.

Dr. Neerja Sood, Programme Co-ordinator presented the additional list of six experts for Course Writing for DNA Programme and the same was approved.

Dr. Biplab Jamatia, Programme Co-ordinator, presented the list of two experts for Course writer/editor, paper setter/ moderator of Certificate programme in Yoga (CPY)Programme, and the same was approved.

#### 70.9 Any other Item

## 70.9.1 To consider the extension period of the students of the PG Diploma in Clinical Cardiology (PGDCC) students

Dr.Biplab Jamatia, Programme Co-ordinator, PGDCC Programme presented a case of Dr.Rahul, Enrollment No.127629040 who has represented for considering extension of his registration period so that he would get additional chance for clearing the left over theory papers. He also mentioned that there was more than 100 candidates who have not completed their Programme as the maximum registration period was over. Moreover, the Programme was not on offer since 2013. So allowing any students to continue at this stage would not be feasible.

After deliberations, it was agreed not to extend the registration period of any student for PGDCC Programme.

#### 70.9.2 Approval of the names for Experts Committee Meeting for the PGDHHM progamme

Prof.T.K.Jena, Programme Co-ordinator, PGDHHM programme presented a list of twelve names for constituting an Expert Committee for revision of PGDHHM Programme for which PRF form was approved by 69<sup>th</sup> School Board Meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2019.

Members approved the names of the experts as proposed.
