NOTIFICATION

Sub: Exemption from appearing in the Term-end-Examination of the First Year courses of Bachelor and Masters Degree: Term-end-Examination, June 2021 in conformity of UGC order dated July 16, 2021.

In continuation of the Notifications dated 3rd July 2021, 9th July, 2021 and 28th October, 2021 on the subject mentioned above, it is further notified that the students of the **following Bachelor and Masters Degree Programmes** who were enrolled in the first year of the Programme in **July 2020 admission session through online mode** and were eligible to appear in the Term-end-Examination, June 2021 for the first time are exempted from appearing in the Term-end-Examination of the first year courses on the analogy of ODL. The marks / grades in the Term-end-Examination of the first year courses will be assigned based on the average marks / grades obtained by the students in the term-end examination of the second year courses.


The exemption is not applicable to any other component such as Practical Examinations, Assignments, Project Reports, Dissertation, Internship, Field Work Journal (Practicum), etc.

The students who do not want the exemption may appear for the Term-end-Examination of the first year courses in the Term-end-Examinations, June 2022 or afterwards till the expiry of the maximum duration of the Programme, subject to the fulfillment of the other eligibility conditions.

The results/marks/grades in the Term-end-Examination of the first year courses, covered under the exemption scheme mentioned above, will be updated by the University only after the completion of the Term-end-Examination of the all courses of second year.

No partial exemption is admissible.
