REPORT OF TERM END EXAMINATIONS HELD DURING 2014-15

During the academic year 2014-15, two term-end examinations were held during December 2014 and June 2015. In December 2014 Term End Examinations, 4.54 lakhs students appeared in 2249 courses across 835 examination centres including 79 Special Learner Support Centres in Jails and 34 Overseas Examination Centres. In June 2015 Term End Examinations, number of examinees appeared were 4.91 lakhs in 2109 courses at 848 examination centres across India and 32 overseas examination centres. The number of answer books evaluated in TEE December 2014 and TEE-June 2015 were 14.75 lakhs and 15.93 lakhs answer books, respectively. In the 27th Convocation of the University held in 2014, the total number of awardees were 2,38,276.

During the academic year 2015-16, two term-end examinations were held during December 2015 and June 2016. In December 2015 Term End Examinations, 4.9 lakhs students appeared in 1967 courses across 876 examination centres including 82 Special Learner Support Centres in Jails and 22 Overseas Examination Centres. In June 2016 Term End Examinations, number of examinees appeared were 5.56 lakhs in 1911 courses at 884 examination centres across India and 49 overseas examination centres. The number of answer books evaluated in TEE December 2015 and TEE-June 2016 were 15.76 lakhs and 18.76 lakhs answer books, respectively. In the 28th Convocation of the University held in 2015, the total number of awardees were 1,91,818.

During the academic year 2016-17, two term-end examinations were held during December 2016 and June 2017. In December 2016 Term End Examinations, 4.76 lakhs students appeared in 1770 courses across 888 examination centres including 91 Special Learner Support Centres in Jails and 18 Overseas Examination Centres. In June 2017 Term End Examinations, number of examinees appeared were 6.24 lakhs in 1779 courses at 1032 examination centres across India and 23 overseas examination centres. The number of answer books evaluated in TEE December 2016 and TEE June 2017 were 14.07 lakhs and 21.08 lakhs answer books, respectively. In the 29th Convocation of the University held in 2016, the total number of awardees were 1,93,662.

In June 2018 Term End Examinations, number of examinees appeared were 5.57 lakhs in 1547 courses at 926 examination centres across India and 18 overseas examination centres. The number of answer books evaluated in TEE December 2017 and TEE June 2018 were 13.94 lakhs and 21.71 lakhs answer books, respectively. During the academic year 2018-19, two term-end examinations were held during December 2018 and June 2019. In December 2018 Term End Examinations, 5.07 lakhs students appeared in 1531 courses at 860 examination centres in India and 17 overseas examination centres. In June 2019 Term End Examinations, number of examinees appeared were 7.59 lakhs in 1357 courses at 910 examination centres across India and 16 overseas examination centres. The number of answer books evaluated in TEE December 2018 and TEE-June 2019 were 17.99 lakhs and 32.48 lakhs answer books, respectively.
