The School Board noted the Action Taken regarding the various activities School 67<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the approved during the The Action Taken with respect to the Point.67.8.2 regarding modification of eligibility criteria for Ph.D. in Child Development was discussed in detail with the School Board members. It was stated that a discussion had taken place in the ACSC meeting that the eligibility criteria for the Ph.D. in Child Development should be the same as for the eligibility criteria recruitment of Assistant Professor in the Discipline of Child Development. The School Board members, especially Prof. R.Baskar and Prof. Arbind Kumar Jha pointed out that the eligibility criteria for Ph.D. can be much broader than the eligibility criteria recruitment of Assistant Professor and the two need not be identical. In keeping with NEP 2020 and its multi-disciplinary approach, students from various disciplinary backgrounds should be encouraged to pursue Ph.D. in a discipline. Citing the example of Ph.D. in Earth and Environmental Sciences, Prof. R.Baskar pointed out that candidates from medical background are also eligible to register for Ph.D. He stated that the eligibility criteria for recruitment of Assistant Professor in any discipline can be changed from timeto-time depending upon the specific requirement of the discipline at that point of time when the recruitment is being made. The School Board agreed with the Discipline of Child Development in expanding its eligibility criteria for Ph.D. as approved in the 67<sup>th</sup> meeting of the School Board.

With this discussion, the ATR was approved.

Prof. Arobindo Mahato presented the Programme Development Form (PDF), Minutes of the Expert Committee Meeting and Programme Project Report (PPR) Form for Bachelor in Rural Studies for consideration and approval of the School Board of SOCE.

The Course Structure developed by the Expert Committee was appreciated. Prof. Monika Mishra and Prof. Deeksha Kapur expressed the view that the component of viva-voce must be introduced in the evaluation component of the Dissertation in order to ensure its authenticity given the fact that there are so many instances of Plagiarism being reported. They suggested that this can be suggested in the future Expert Committee Meetings organized by the discipline since the Dissertation component is only in the fourth year. Prof. Arbind Kumar Jha emphasized that when the course on Research Methodology is being developed, care should be taken to ensure that a variety of qualitative research approaches are discussed such as Ethnography, Focus Group Discussions and Grounded Theory. Prof. Mahato clarified that the

Research Methodology course which is proposed to be adopted for BRS had been recently revised but the discipline would look into it.

Regarding the disciplines and subjects, which could be taken up as Minor by the BRS students, Prof. Mahato also proposed to include the following streams apart from the ones mentioned in the syllabus structure in the PDF Form. These streams are Computer Literacy, Commerce, Social Audit, and Gender and Development Studies. Prof. Mahato also proposed that if a Minor Course on Research Methodology is available then the same could be scrutinized and if found relevant could be added to the stream of Minor Courses in addition to the Core Discipline Course in Research Methodology.

Prof. Deeksha Kapur emphasized the importance of including Food Security, Public Distribution Systems and Rural Health in greater detail. It was suggested that this point may be discussed during the Course Writers' meeting so that this content is not missed.

The School Board appreciated the initiative of launching Bachelor's in Rural Studies as it would give a direction to the growth of the discipline at the Under Graduate Level and provide high opportunities of employability.
