The School Board took note of the ATR and congratulated the faculty members on their timely progress on the various academic activities of their respective disciplines and programmes.

#### Agenda Item 3

To consider and approve the Programme Development Form (PDF), Programme Project Report (PPR) Form and Minutes of the Expert Committee Meeting along with detailed syllabus for B.Sc. (Hons) (Food and Nutrition) (FYUP).

SB 70.3.1

Prof. Deeksha Kapur presented the Programme Development Form (PDF), Programme Project Report (PPR) Form and Minutes of the Expert Committee Meeting for B.Sc. (Hons) (Food and Nutrition) (FYUP) for consideration and approval of the School Board of SOCE. The Members appreciated the detailed syllabus. Discussion took place regarding the eligibility criteria, and it was decided that the eligibility criteria may be modified as follows:

- i. 10+2 pass from Science stream **OR**
- ii. 10+2 pass from Arts stream with Home Science as one of the subject **OR**
- iii. 10+2 pass from Arts/Commerce stream (without Home Science) with Certificate in Food and Nutrition (CFN) offered by IGNOU. Simultaneous admission to CFN along with B.Sc. (Food and Nutrition) will be provided.

SB 70.3.2

The School Board considered and approved the Programme Development Form (PDF), Programme Project Report (PPR) Form and Minutes of the Expert Committee Meeting along with detailed syllabus for B.Sc. (Hons) (Food and Nutrition) (FYUP).

The members of the School Board were of the view that the objective of enrolling in CFN is lost if the student does not successfully complete it within the first year of enrolling for the B.Sc. Programme. The School Board also took cognizance of the point raised by the Nutritional Sciences Faculty that IGNOU processes allow a two-year period for completion of CFN.
