Discussion: The revised Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA_NEW/BCA_NEWOL) programme offered by SOCIS was introduced in July 2024, in accordance with IGNOU Notification No. IG/SRD/R-IV/2022/974 dated 24 August 2022. The programme carries a total of 120 credits, distributed as 40 credits per year.

The exit options are available for learners who successfully complete the following stages:

1. On Completion of the First and Second Semesters – Award of “Undergraduate Certificate in Computer Applications.”
2. On Completion of the First, Second, Third, and Fourth Semesters – Award of “Undergraduate Diploma in Computer Applications.”

To consider and approve the revision of the payment norms for Evaluation of Project Synopsis under the courses BCSP-064, BCSP-165 and MCSP-232 of BCA/BCAOL/BCA_NEW/BCA_NEWOL and MCA_NEW/MCA_NEWOL Programmes of IGNOU.

Discussion:

The existing payment norms for Evaluation of Project Synopsis under the courses BCSP-064, BCSP-165 and MCSP-232 of BCA/BCAOL/BCA_NEW/BCA_NEWOL and MCA_NEW/MCA_NEWOL Programmes of IGNOU were instituted about 25 years back @ Rs 15 per synopsis. It is observed that other schools are performing the same activity for Evaluation of Project Synopsis under their respective courses at the payment norm of Rs 50 per synopsis. In the light of the above facts the school proposes to revise of the payment norms for Evaluation of Project Synopsis under the courses BCSP-064, BCSP-165 and MCSP-232 of BCA/BCAOL/BCA_NEW/BCA_NEWOL and MCA_NEW/MCA_NEWOL Programmes of IGNOU.

In addition, it is also proposed to revise the existing handling charges of Synopsis and Project evaluation at Regional Centers (RC's) under the courses BCSP064, BCSP165 and MCSP 232 of BCA/BCAOL/BCA_NEW/BCA_NEWOL and MCA_NEW/MCA_NEWOL Programmes of IGNOU, as follows:

1. Synopsis Handling charges: Present payment Norms – 0; Proposed Payment Norms – Rs 10/Synopsis
2. Project Report and Viva Handling charges: Present payment Norms – 10; Proposed Payment Norms – Rs 25/Project report
