At the outset, the Chairperson welcomed all the members to the 46th meeting of the School Board of School of Education. She put on record the contibution of the former Chairperson of the School Board, Prof. N.K. Dash from whom she assumed/took the Charge of the Chairperson. The School Board recorded its appreciation of the significant contribution of the outgoing Charperson and welcomed the new Chairperson.

The apenda items were then taken up for discussion.

# Item No. 46.1 To confirm the minutes of the 45th Meeting of the School Board of the School of Education.

The Chairperson informed the Board that the Minutes of 45<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the School Board of School of Education held on July 15, 2016 were circulated to the Members. The Chairperson also informed the members of the actions

taken by the faculty members in the light of the minutes and presented the same to the School Board.

The Chairperson informed the members that no comments have been received on the minutes from any member of the School Board so far. Since no other observations/comments were received, the Board approved the minutes.

Item No. 46.2 To report the Action Taken on the minutes of 45<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the School Board of School of Education

The Chairperson informed the members of the actions taken by the faculty members on the minutes of 45<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the School Board of the School of Education held on 15.07.2016 and presented the same to the School Board.

The Chairperson apprised the Board about the ATR which was noted by the School Board.

Item No. 46.3 To consider and approve the concept note of the proposal of (1) 'B.A. (Honours) Education (as per Choice Based Credit System of UGC) and (2) 'B.A. with Education' under the Bachelor Degree Programme of IGNOU (as per Choice Based Credit System of UGC)

The School Board was apprised that the School of Education has initiated to include 'B.A. (Honours) Education' and 'B.A. with Education' as per the CBCS system of UGC. B.A. (Honours) Education will be an independent programme of School of Education, IGNOU. B.A. with Education as a Subject will be included at the Bachelor Degree Level under the BDP of IGNOU. At present IGNOU is revising Bachelor Degree Programme across the subjects as per the CBCS format. Keeping in view the above, School of Education has prepared proposals of 'B.A. (Honours) Education and B.A. with Education'. The proposals have been discussed in the 66th, 67th and 68th School Council meeting as well as with the Discipline Coordinators of School of Social Sciences. In principle, the proposal has been accepted.

As per the CBCS format, for 'B.A. (Honours) Education', 14 Core courses and 06 Discipline Specific Elective Courses (Students have to select 04 DSE courses) have been suggested in the proposal. For B.A. (Honours) Education, the SOE, IGNOU, will develop 14 core courses and 06 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses on education whereas the other required courses such as Ability Enhancement Compulsory, Courses (AECC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and Genereic Elective (GE) will be taken from the general pool of CBCS BDP programme of IGNOU. B.A. (Honours) Education has been proposed to offer on July, 2019 session.

For 'B.A. with Education as a subject, 04 Core Courses and 06 Discipline Specific Elective Courses (Students have to select any 02 DSE Courses) have been suggested. This will not be an independent programme. It will be

offered under the CBCS BDP programme of IGNOU. Core and DSE Courses for 'B.A. with Education' will be taken from the Core and DSE Courses suggested in B.A. (Honours) Education. No separate courses will be developed for 'B.A. with Education'. B.A. with Education has been proposed to offer on July, 2018 session.

The concept note of 'B.A. (Honours) Education' and 'B.A. with Education' (as per Choice Based Credit System of UGC) under the Bachelor Degree Programme of IGNOU is placed in the School Board meeting for consideration and approval.

The School Board considered the Item and after deliberations at length it was felt that the note lacks clarity about BA (Honours in Education) and BA with Education. However, the School Board approved the proposal in principle with the observation that the note should be modified with clarity about the Programmes(s) to be launched. The School Board authorised the Chairperson, School Board, SOE to finalize it.

Item No. 46.4 To consider and approve the list of experts suggested for constituting Expert Committee for conducting Expert Committee meeting of (1) B.A (Honours) Education and (2) 'B.A. with Education' under the Bachelor Degree Programme of IGNOU.

The Chairperson informed the School Board about the list of experts submitted by the Programme Coordinator.
