Significance of oral/short methods applied for Salva (Geometry) Decimal place, value numeration, Quadratic Equation, Calculus and other areas in contemporary education. 4. Contribution of Ancient Indian Mathematicians in the contemporary curriculum of Mathematics. After detailed discussion, the School Board approved the Programme. (Secondary), (ii) B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary) & (iii) B.Com. B.Ed. (Secondary) The Chairperson informed that the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) has recognized 42 institutions on a pilot basis to launch the four-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) from the session 2023 and it is to be underlined that School of Education, IGNOU is one of the 42 institutions. The School of Education, IGNOU is now in the process of launching 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programmes (ITEPs) for B.A. B.Ed. (Secondary)-100 seats, B.Sc. B.Ed. (Secondary) -100 Seats and B.Com. B.Ed. (Secondary) - 100 Seats. NTA in coordination with NCTE, conducted an all-India entrance test for admission to the various levels of ITEP on 9th August 2023 and declared the result of the same. The result was sent to each institution during the first week of Sept. 2023. The Director and members of faculty involved in ITEP, SOE attended <i>Orientation to the ITEP: Curriculum framework / suggestive syllabi</i> on 31st Aug 2023, conducted by NCTE. After the meeting, SOE received the detailed curriculum and syllabus on 5th Sept. 2023 and it has been decided to adopt the same model curriculum and syllabus as suggested by NCTE.
