Prof. Mahendra Dev, Prof. S.Y.Shah and Prof. Manohar Lal could not attend the meeting.

At the outset, Dr. B. K. Pattanaik, Director, SOEDS welcomed the members and special invitee and briefed them about the progress made in finalizing the academic programme and agenda of the 4th School Board Meeting. Prof. Parvin Sinclair, Pro- Vice Chancellor, in her address to the participants emphasized the importance of academic programmes in the field of Extension and Development Studies. This was followed by item-wise discussion on the agenda. The outcomes of the school board meeting are as follows:

SB 4.1 To Consider approval of converting MA in Development Studies to MA in Extension and Development Studies

SB 4.1.1 The members agreed that the combination of extension and development studies is very unique and need of the hour to train human resources in the combined area of extension and development studies. They appreciated and approved the conversion of MA in Development Studies to MA in Extension and Development Studies.

SB 4.2 to 4.8 To Consider approval of the Phase-I and Phase-III forms of:

- Certificate in Extension and Development Studies ODL Mode
- Postgraduate Diploma in Extension and Development Studies ODL Mode
- MA in Extension and Development Studies ODL Mode
- MA in Extension and Development Studies Face to Face Mode (no phase forms)



All the members had a detailed discussion on various courses of the programme. Some of the observations made by the members are as follows:

- The rationale for the flow with in the courses and among the courses be clearly spelt out
- Some minor modifications in the titles of the courses
- The courses like 'Local Self Government and Development' and 'Gender and Development' are very important elective courses
- While finalizing the course contents, the credit weightage must be kept in mind to avoid overloading the learners.

SB 4.2.1 – 4.8.1: After a detailed discussion, the School Board approved the Phase-I and Phase-III forms of the Certificate, Postgraduate Diploma and MA Programmes of Extension and Development Studies (Please see Appendix II).

SB 4.9: To consider approval of Experts for MA in Extension and Development Studies (Face to Face to be launched in July 2009)

SB 4.9.1 The School Board discussed the proposed names and suggested some more experts as guest faculty. The recommended list is enclosed as Appendix III.
