- Prof. S.V.N. Rao, briefed the members about the importance of a Dictorrespondence of a Animal Husbandry Extension to meet the continuous education needs of field veterinarians. He informed that the target population for the programme will be around 50000 field veterinarians 50000 para-veterinarians, plus around 2000 graduates admitted every year into veterinary colleges in the country besides international students. Members approved the proposal to launch Diploma programme in Animal Husbandry Extension and to Dr. P.V.K. Sasidhar to prepare programme proposal and tentative contents. The Members have suggested calling an expert group meeting to finalize title of the programme, courses, credits, contents and course writers.
