- SB 20.13.4 The School Board Members after detailed perusal, review and deliberations approved and recommended the extension of one year period from the date of expiry of maximum period of five years to complete Ph.D in Law in respect of Sri Manoj Kumar Patel, Enrollment No. 149500013 July, 2014 cycle.

### Item No.20.14.1Tabled item: To consider and approve the proposal for relaxing the eligibility conditions for the Programme PGCPP from the present eligibility conditions.

SB 20.14.1 The programme Coordinator Dr. Suneet K. Srivastava informed the School Board Members that the existing eligibility condition for the intake of students in PGCPP is highly restricted to a very specific target group as detailed below:-

The existing status (eligibility criteria): Any degree in science technology/medicine of fourth and fifty years students of five year integrated LLB Course who had passed first three years. The coordinator explained because of such restricted eligibility criteria the enrolment in the programme is very poor.

- SB 20.14.2 The programme Coordinator proposed that the existing criteria may be changed to graduate in any discipline.
- SB 20.14.3 Prof. S. K. Panda, STRIDE explained that the criteria may further be extended to students of integrated courses too. After detailed deliberations it was decided by the School Board that the eligibility criteria of intake for students in PGCPP may be graduate in any discipline or a student after Completion of three years in any four / five years integrated programme done after plus 2 has to submit the consolidated grade card / certificate of completion of three years alongwith the application.
- SB 20.14.3 After detailed deliberations, the above changes in the eligibility criterion for the programme PGCPP was duty approved by the School Board.
