

She said that the Management Programme has started in 1987. There was a need for such a programme to strengthen the managers in order enhance and up date their knowledge and skills. It was a flagship programme of the University with a very high enrolment. In fact, IGNOU was known and became popular because of the programme. About three decades back, IGNOU was the only University offering Manageme Programme through Open and Distance Learning (ODL). But now sever					

universities/institutes are offering the programme in ODL. The enrolment for the past five years has reduced tremendously. This was the concern to the Ministry as well as to the Vice-Chancellor. This concern has lead to the restructuring of the programme. The Board deliberated on the issue and suggested that: 37.9.2 (a) In relation to the proposal 'B' mentioned in the Agenda it was decided to drop the following para With this background it is proposed that the School Board may ratify the resolution of 49th AC and 40th DEC decision. (b) In relation to the proposal D mentioned in the agenda one specialization was missing i.e. Post Graduate Diploma in Financial Markets Practices (PGDFMP) which has to be added along with other specialization programmes. (c) There should not be direct entry to PGDIM Board felt that these changes are essential to strengthen the programme. The Board considered and approved the management programme restructuring with the above mentioned changes. Prof. Srilatha tabled the Phase 1 form .
