He said "The reservation policy of Government of India in terms of percentage of allotment of seats with regard to SC, ST, OBC and PH has not been followed". After detailed discussion on this matter, it was observed that there are no clear cut guidelines available on the operational point of the rules on reservation for admission in Ph.D/M.Phil Programmes.
