They are MBA, MBA (Banking & Finance), and 4 Specialisation Post Graduate Diplomas (Post Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management, Post Graduate Diploma in Financial Management, Post Graduate Diploma in Operations Management, and Post Graduate Diploma in Marketing Management) Programmes.
- The School has launched the B.Com. (CBCS) programme through online mode from July 2021 session onwards.
- Two of the Faculty Members; Prof. Kamal Yadava, and Dr. Gopal Jadhav, who were members of the Board, has taken VRS and left the University.

the old courses and the new courses in order to ensure smooth transition from the old programmes to the new programmes. For this smooth transition the following are proposed:

- a. All the study centers which are activated for old MP and the MPB shall automatically continue as study centers for the New MBA and the MBF programmes.
- b. All the Counsellors of the earlier courses in the old programmes shall automatically stand approved for the corresponding courses in the new programmes.
- c. All the Evaluators of Term End Examination of the earlier courses in the old programmes shall also automatically stand approved for the corresponding courses in the new programmes.
- d. All the paper setters/ moderators of Term End Examination of the earlier courses in the old programmes shall also automatically stand approved for the corresponding courses in the new programmes.
- e. Common counseling sessions are to be conducted for corresponding courses in the new and the old programmes as have been mapped. This is necessary for avoiding duplication of efforts and to ensure logistic feasibility of conducting counseling.

The above operational issues are placed for consideration and approval of the School Board

The School Board approved the mapping of Courses of MP and the MPB Programmes with the courses of the proposed new MBA and the MBA (Banking and Finance) Programmes as at Annexure 47.05.01.

47.06

To consider and approve the validity period of assignments as one (01) year for all the Courses of existing MP and MPB Programmes as well as for the proposed New MBA and MBA (Banking and Finance) Programmes.

47.06.01

Prof. Kamal Vagrecha, Discipline Coordinator (Management), presented the item and informed the members of the School Board that the evaluation system of the MBA, the P.G. Diplomas, and the MBA (Banking and Finance) has two components, i.e. (i) Assignment 30% weightage and (ii) the Term End Examination (70% weightage). Grading system is followed in these programmes.

He further informed that presently the validity of assignment of each course is six months. Earlier all the courses of MP and MPB used to be on offer in both the semesters. Later, keeping in view the logistic and other reasons, semester-wise break-up was approved by the university. As per this break-up, some of the courses of specialization and elective courses are offered in January Semester and some more in the July Semester. Accordingly, the assignments for those particular courses are prepared in that particular semester only with validity of six months.

He also informed that due to this semester-wise break-up, student who choose a particular course for January semester and could not submit his assignment in that semester do not have the assignment for that course in July semester, as the assignments for that course may not be available in July semester. As a result the learner would not be able to write the examination for that course in July Semester.

July 30, 2021

There have been number of representations from the students on this issue requesting the School to make all the assignments available in all the semesters.

In view the genuine problem of the students, particularly when the maximum period is reduced to 4 years for MBA, it is proposed that the validity of assignments of all the courses be made as one year (2 semesters). This is proposed for the existing MP (including PG Diplomas) and the MPB Programmes as well as the new/revised Master of Business Administration (MBA) and the Master of Business Administration (Banking and Finance) (MBF) Programmes.

The School Board approved the validity period of assignments as one (01) year (2 semesters) for all the Courses of existing MP (including the PG Diplomas) and the MPB Programmes as well as for the New MBA and MBA (Banking and Finance) Programmes.

47.07.01

Prof. Nayantara Padhi presented the item and informed the members of School Board that Discipline of Management, SOMS, is restructuring the Management Programme and MBA (Banking and Finance) Programmes. The proposal for revised Master of Business Administration (MBA) Programme and Master of Business Administration (Banking and Finance) (MBF) alongwith the Programme Revision Form (PRF) and the Concept Note were duly approved by the School Board in its 44th Meeting held on March 20, 2020. Subsequently, the same was duly approved by the Vice Chancellor and later ratified by the Academic Council Standing Committee in its 53rd Meeting held on April 16, 2021. Both the programmes are going to be offered from the July 2021 session.

She further informed that subsequently, the university applied for AICTE approval and got the AICTE approval for the MBA, MBF and 4 Specialisation Post Graduate Diplomas (Post Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management, Post Graduate Diploma in Financial Management, Post Graduate Diploma in Operations Management, and Post Graduate Diploma in Marketing Management) Programmes of the School.

She also informed that as per AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2021-22, the eligibility criteria for admission to MBA Programme is as follows:

"Passed Bachelor Degree of Minimum 3 years duration. Obtained at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying examination."

In view of the above, it is proposed to change the eligibility criteria for admission to MBA and the MBA (Banking and Finance) (MBF) Programmes as follows:

For MBA:

"Passed Bachelor Degree of Minimum 3 years duration with at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category)."

MBF:

"For admission to the MBA (Banking & Finance) (MBF) programme, the candidate should satisfy the following conditions:

- a) Passed Bachelor Degree of Minimum 3 years duration with at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category).
- b) He/ She should have passed the CAIIB examinations of the Indian Institute of Banking & Finance, Mumbai, and awarded the requisite qualification/credentials therefor by the Institute;
- c) He/ She should have been working with the Banking or Financial Services sector for a period of at least two years."

Since there is no requirement of entrance test for admission to MBA programme, as per the AICTE Handbook, qualifying in OPENMAT is no more required.

Eligibility conditions (b) & (c) are added as additional eligibility conditions for admission to the MBF programme, as they are stipulated by the MOU between IGNOU and the IIBF.

	Further the Director also informed the Members that the other 4 PG Diplomas, viz.; Post Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management, Post Graduate Diploma in Financial Management, Post Graduate Diploma in Operations Management, and Post Graduate Diploma in Marketing Management, will continue to be offered in their present form as they have been approved by the AICTE.

BCOC-136: Income Tax Law and Practice is a core course in both of these programmes.
