The Programme Coordinator, Dr. Sonia Sharma apprised the members about the 42<sup>nd</sup> & 43<sup>rd</sup> Doctoral Committee Meeting. The minutes of the meeting was placed and was discussed in detail as agenda item of the School Board.

**Item No. SB: 26.4 (A):**

**Change in the Courses offered in the Online Certificate in Tourism Studies (CTS) Programme**

Programme Coordinator, Dr. Paramita Suklabaidya informed the members that the Online Certificate in Tourism Studies (CTS) Programme of the School is on offer from January 2020. As approved in the 25th School Board Meeting, CTS online was offered as a 20 Credit Programme instead of 16 Credit Programme as offered in the ODL mode; by the means of introducing a 04 Credits Course - Dissertation. As per Guidelines of Online Programmes/ Course of the University, any Online programmes of the University can now be offered with same credits as that of the respective ODL programme. In the light of the new guidelines, Programme Coordinator proposed that the CTS Online Programme maybe reverted to 16 Credits Programme same as that of ODL CTS Programme.

*Members discussed and observed that reverting back to 16 credits for CTS Online Programme will be as per the Guidelines of the Online Programmes / Courses of IGNOU. Members approved the change of credits from 20 to 16 for the CTS Online Programme of the School.*

**Item No. SB: 26.4 (B):**

**Revised Syllabus Structure of the Certificate in Tourism Studies (CTS) Programme**

Programme Coordinator, Dr. Paramita Suklabaidya informed the members that the Certificate in Tourism Studies (CTS) Programme of the School is on offer since 1994. As approved by the 24<sup>th</sup> School Board, an Academic Expert Committee Meeting was held on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019 for the revision of the Programme. Minutes of the meeting were placed in the 25<sup>th</sup> School Board meeting wherein experts had recommended that the present CTS Programme may be revised /restructured as an 18 Credits Programme with 03 courses of 06 credits each, so as to incorporate the prevailing changes in the Tourism Industry. Further, as per the recent directives of Director P&DD and as approved by the Academic Council, all Certificate Programmes of the University must be of 16 credits and not 18 credits. Considering the same, it was proposed by the programme coordinator that the credit of one of the courses maybe changed to 04 credits instead of 06 Credits.

*Members discussed and observed that the restructuring and revising of the programme with 03 Courses instead of present 02 Courses is needed to incorporate the changes in the dynamic industry of tourism. Further, members approved the change of credits from 18 to 16 Credits with 03 courses in the revised syllabus of the CTS Programme of the School as per details below:*

**Item No. SB: 26.5 (A):**

**Reporting of the approval to offer Diploma in Tourism Studies (DTS) as an Online Programme and the courses on offer**

Programme Coordinator, Dr. Paramita Suklabaidya informed the members that the Diploma in Tourism Studies (DTS) Programme of the School is on offer since 1990s and was launched as an online programme of the School from July 2020 with the approval of the Academic Council and the Honourable Vice Chancellor. DTS programme offered on ODL mode is a 36 Credits programme consisting of Core / Compulsory and Elective Courses. It was proposed and approved in the 52nd Academic Council Standing Committee (ACSC) meeting that DTS programme may be offered online with only Core / Compulsory Courses with 01 project – compulsory from July 2020 session onwards.

Members noted that the agenda item is a reporting item and that the online DTS programme with the following compulsory courses, including project (and no elective course), will be on offer from July 2020 academic session:

**Revised Syllabus Structure of the Diploma in Tourism (DTS) Programme**

Programme Coordinator, Dr. Paramita Suklabaidya informed the members that the Diploma in Tourism Studies (DTS) Programme of the School is on offer since 1990s. As approved by the 24<sup>th</sup> School Board, an Academic Expert Committee Meeting was held on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019 for the revision of the Programme. Minutes of the meeting were placed in the 25<sup>th</sup> School Board meeting wherein experts had recommended that the present DTS Programme may be revised/restructured as an 36 Credits Programme with 06 courses of 06 credits each, so as to incorporate the prevailing changes in the Tourism Industry. Further, as per the recent directives of Director P&DD and as approved by the Academic Council, all Diploma Programmes of the University must be of 32 credits. Considering the same, it was proposed by the programme coordinator that the credit of two of the courses maybe changed to 04 credits instead of 06 Credits.

Members discussed and observed that the restructuring and revising of the programme is much required so as to incorporate the changes in the dynamic industry of tourism. Further, members approved the change of credits from 36 to 32 Credits with 06 courses in the revised syllabus of the DTS Programme of the School as per details below:

**Item No. SB: 26.8:**

**Reporting approved structure/syllabus of BTS Online and ODL programmes**

The Programme Coordinator Dr Arvind Kumar Dubey reported that School of Tourism and Hospitality Services Management has launched Bachelor of Arts in Tourism Studies Programme (BTS) in Online Mode from July 2020 session. As per requirement of online mode, the programme has been converted into semesters. In online mode the programme will be of six semesters of 16 credits each (96 credits total). The ODL structure (year wise) to be offered from July 2021 session and online structure (semester wise) offered from July 2020 session is attached herewith for reporting to SB. The structure of BTS programme has been finalized as per courses and programmes offered by the University in online mode i.e. courses of Computer Sciences (CIT 1, 2, 3-English medium only); Event Management (BHC 11, 12, 13 - English medium only) and BAVTM courses (BTMS 185) have been incorporated. In ODL mode of BTS Programme, the online courses have been offered as elective/optional. There is no change in School of Tourism and Hospitality Services Management's courses i.e. Tourism Courses (TS Courses). In previous ODL mode there were three project reports of 12 credits. Now the learners will submit only two project reports.

The BTS Programme Structure/ Course Structure in ODL and Online Mode are already approved by Academic Council Standing Committee in its meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020 (ACSC 52.38). Minutes of said ACSC was approved in 74<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2020. The structure and syllabus as approved by ACSC was placed before the School Board as reporting item.


