6.	SB: 43.06	To consider and recommend the discontinuation of Post Graduate Diploma in Pharmaceutical Sales Management (PGDPSM) programme.
	43.06.1	Programme Coordinator informed that the Post Graduate Diploma in Pharmaceutical Sales Management (PGDPSM) Programme was launched in 2009 by the faculty of SOS. However, the programme was housed in SOVET. The Programme comprises of 6 courses of which 4 Courses are from Pharmacy discipline while other two are from Management discipline. The objective of the programme was to upgrade the knowledge in Pharmaceutical & Management discipline and to award post graduate diploma to professionals already working in Pharmaceutical sector not leading to any license for Pharmacy.
		Recently, it has been brought to the notice of UGC Notifications dated 19 th Sept. 2023 and 4 th Sept. 2020; "Pharmacy discipline programmes and their allied domains are not permitted to be offered in ODL and Online mode". Thus, advice of the competent authority was sought for future course of action. It was suggested that proposal need to be placed before School Board.
		Members discussed in detail and were having different points of view whether this Diploma programme falls under perview of Public notification or not, this notification implied to Degree level programme in Pharmacy sector through ODL not for certificate or Diploma. The programme on offer doesn't have any practical components, it is meant for awareness programme only. Members also suggested that said programme can be revised in view of notification and can be made more sales oriented.

But she left the programnme in-between and did not attend the remaining classes nor she submitted assignments of some courses. The school contacted her twice through mail and telephonically, but she did not respond. Programme Coordinator further informed that she was also invited to present her research proposal subject to completion of her course work, but she did not turn up.
		The item was also placed in the last Doctoral Committee meeting and appraised in the 42 nd School Board meeting held on 8 th April 2024. The School Board advised to send reminder through e-mail and by post to her postal address, whether she is willing to continue her research work or not. The school mailed dated 10 th April, 2024 and through post but she has not responded so far. The student's status is that she has not completed her course work and has shortage of attendance as per university norms.
		The Doctoral Research Committee discussed this item in its 38 th meeting held on 1 st October, 2024 in depth and recommends to the School Board that student's registration be cancelled due to failure to
		complete her course work.
