It was noted that under the network system, 60% of the material would be common and would be prepared by the ICNOU and leaving 40% of the material for State Open Universities specially

w cater to the local needs. The Chairman explained that a meeting between representative of the Department of Education, University Gravitation and the Vice-Chancellor Indira Gand Rational Cpen University will be held soon and the modalities in regard to the funding, controver quality, avoidance of duplication of material etc. vould be worked out.

In regard to the continuance of correspondence education in existing Universities. the Chairm explainer! that possibly the institutions of correspondence education be wound up or merged with the State Open Universities as and when a State Open University is set up in a State.
