- Overall impact

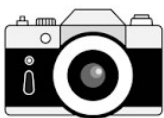
### Theme for Poetry Competition

#### Rules and Guidelines

1. **Participation:** Open to all students of IGNOU and Children of IGNOU Teachers & Staff.
2. Each participant may submit one or two (maximum) photographs only.
3. You will have to certify that the submitted photograph(s) has been clicked by you.
4. Your photo should align with the theme – ‘**Rights, Equality and Empowerment: Shaping a Future for Every Girl**’.
5. It is mandatory to give a caption for your photograph.
6. Basic editing, including colour enhancement and use of filters, is acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity / genuineness of the photograph. Advanced editing is not allowed.
7. Images taken from internet or generated by artificial intelligence (AI) will not be considered.
8. Photograph(s) submitted must be of the dimension 8’’x10’’.

  - **Technical excellence:** The quality of the image including sharpness, colour, and print quality.
  - **Creativity:** The originality and freshness of the image.

- **Message conveyed:** The image's ability to evoke imagination and convey a story.
- **Focus:** The image should have a sharp, crisp focus, on the main subject
