





- 2. Team Size: Maximum of 4 participants per team.


3. Materials:

- Use of colours and presentation
- Overall impact

Rules and Guidelines

- 3. Poetry should be neatly handwritten / typed on a white A4 sheet.
- 4. Poetry must be not less than eight (8) lines and original.
- 5. You will have to certify that the submitted poetry has been written by you.
- 6. Submissions must be in English or Hindi only.
- 7. The poetry must align with the theme 'Rights, Equality and Empowerment: Shaping a Future for Every Girl'.

8. Judging Criteria:

- Relevance to the theme
- Creativity
- Rhythm
- Flow
- Beauty of language

- Top 2 entries will get a prize and a certificate.

Rules and Guidelines

- 1. **Participation**: Open to all students of IGNOU and Children of IGNOU Teachers & Staff.
- 2. Each participant may submit one or two (maximum) photographs only.
- 3. You will have to certify that the submitted photograph(s) has been clicked by you.
- 4. Your photo should align with the theme 'Rights, Equality and Empowerment: Shaping a Future for Every Girl'.
- 5. It is mandatory to give a caption for your photograph.
- 6. Basic editing, including colour enhancement and use of filters, is acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity / genuineness of the photograph. Advanced editing is not allowed.
- 7. Images taken from internet or generated by artificial intelligence (AI) will not be considered.
- 8. Photograph(s) submitted must be of the dimension 8''x10''.
- 9. Submissions have to be in hard copy (print). Post the photograph to the following address –

- 10. To avoid confusion of identity, mention your name at the back of the photograph.

- 12. Judging Criteria:
 - **Technical excellence**: The quality of the image including sharpness, colour, and print quality.
 - **Creativity**: The originality and freshness of the image.

- Message conveyed: The image's ability to evoke imagination and convey a story.
- Focus: The image should have a sharp, crisp focus, on the main subject
