Animal Welfare Laws, Policies and Organizations

Answer all the questions. Each question carries 20 marks

1. Illustrate the animal welfare legislation and policy commitment in India with examples.
2. What are the common offences against animals? How and whom to report the cruelty to animals?
3. Discuss the relation between International Conventions and National Legislations on animal welfare. Elucidate the conservation of wildlife, migratory species and whales.
4. Discuss the salient features of licensing of farriers, registration of cattle premises, application of fines and capture of animals rules.
5. Discuss the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Transport of Animals on Foot) Rules, 2001.
