Guidelines

1. Define sustainable development. Critically analyze the role of public administration in overcoming institutional bottlenecks to accelerate the localization of the Sustainable Development Goals.
2. Delineate the administrative, political, and fiscal dimensions of decentralisation. Assess the fiscal decentralisation architectures of a developed and a developing country, highlighting how resource asymmetry impacts local autonomy.
3. Evaluate the core pillars of urban structural reform initiatives launched by the Government of India. Critically examine the structural deficiencies and implementation gaps that hinder their desired outcomes.
4. Elaborate on the foundational principles of Community-Based Disaster Management (CBDM). Discuss sustainable strategies to transition from top-down administrative response mechanisms to resilient, community-led risk reduction frameworks.
5. Explain the concept of an Environmental Management System (EMS). Using case studies, discuss how integrating an EMS framework helps Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) improve ecological compliance, optimize resources, and mitigate climate risks.
