- 3. c) is written neatly and clearly;
- 4. d) Reflects your understanding of the units.

You will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- fulfilling and completing all aspects of the task/question;
- how you have dealt with your ideas;
- whether you used appropriate linkers
- did you make adequate use of paragraphs;
- range and correctness of vocabulary;
- accuracy of grammatical structures.

Please remember that it is compulsory to submit your assignments before you can take the Term End Exams. Also, remember to keep a copy of your assignments with you and do take a receipt from your Study Centre when you submit the assignments.
