1. Select a topic, as per your interest, from the range of topics given below.
2. Maximum limit for Project Work is Four thousand words/12 pages.
3. Project can be written in Russian/ English.
4. Copying directly from any source online/printed is strictly prohibited.
5. Clearly mention at the end of work all the important sources you have consulted (online/print).
6. Synopsis for the project must be approved by Russian Faculty, SOFL/ M.A or Russian Academic Counsellors engaged in teaching M.A. Russian courses at respective Regional Centres of IGNOU.

Note: You may be aware that you need to submit your Project before you can appear for the Term End Exams. Remember to keep a copy of your completed Project, just in case the one you submitted is lost in transit.
