7. Examine Muhammad bin Tughlaq as an idealist caught between vision and political reality.
8. Discuss *Karukku* as a narrative of caste, gender and resistance.
9. How does *Prem Chand: His Life and Times* combine biography with literary history?
10. Comment on the use of irony in *The Compromise*.
