- 2 Discuss the Government Health Policies in India. Explain the objectives, major provisions, implementation strategies, challenges and future directions of recent national health policies in strengthening the Indian healthcare delivery system. 10
- 3 Discuss the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of National Health Mission (NHM). Explain its achievements, challenges and its contribution towards strengthening India's healthcare delivery system. 10
- 4 Discuss the role of International Organizations Working in Health in improving global health. Explain the functions, achievements and contributions of WHO, UNICEF, World Bank, UNFPA, GAVI and other international agencies in strengthening healthcare systems. 10
