Guidelines for Doing Assignments

Before attempting the assignments please read the detailed instructions provided in the Programme Guide sent to you separately.

You will find it useful to keep the following points in mind while writing the assignments:

- a) **Planning:** Read the assignments carefully, go through the units on which they are based. Make some points regarding each question and then rearrange them in a logical order.
- b) **Organization:** Be a little selective and analytic before drawing up a rough outline of your answer. In an essay type question, give adequate attention to your introduction and conclusion. The introduction must offer your brief interpretation of the question and

how you propose to develop it. The conclusion must summarise your answer to the question.

Make sure that your answer

- Is logical and coherent;
- Has clear connections between sentences and paragraphs;
- Is written correctly giving adequate consideration to your expression, style and presentation.

Note: You may have to study other reference books apart from study material.

3. Discuss the various means of prevention of the cyber crime. Elaborate the role of technology in the prevention of cyber crimes.
4. Explain the notion of jurisdiction vis-a-vis cyberspace.
5. Discuss the role of WIPO.
6. Discuss Enforcement issues in Cyberspace.
7. Discuss various forms of Online Dispute Resolution.
8. Explain the 'effects' Doctrine and its application in computer crimes with the help of case laws.
9. Define computer forensic science. Explain its scope, objectives and importance in cyber crime investigation.
10. Discuss the salient features of Information Technology Act.
