Summary of the Feedback from Subject Experts is given below:

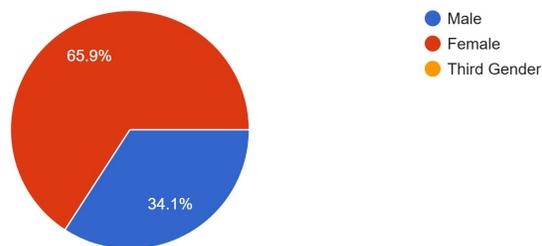
**1. Total number of responses:**

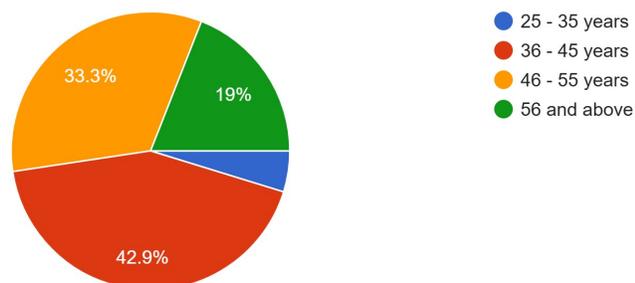


**Fig. 1: Pie diagram of the gender distribution of the respondents**

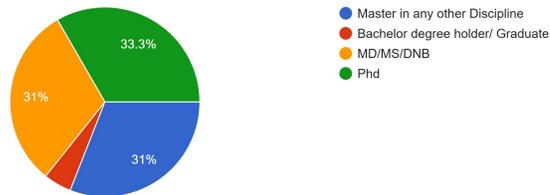


**Fig 2: Pie-chart regarding age group of subject experts**

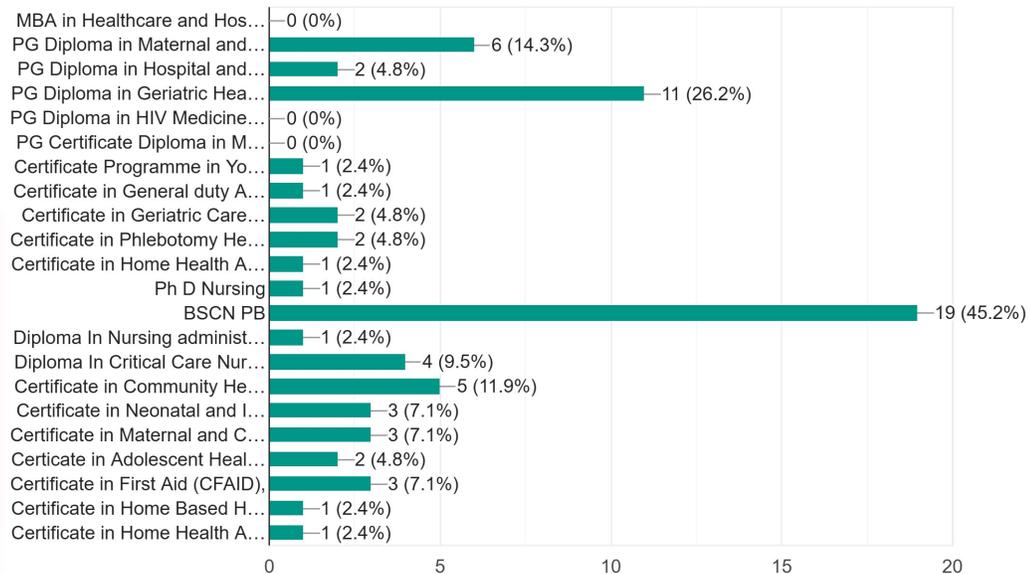
**6. Name of the programme involved with:**

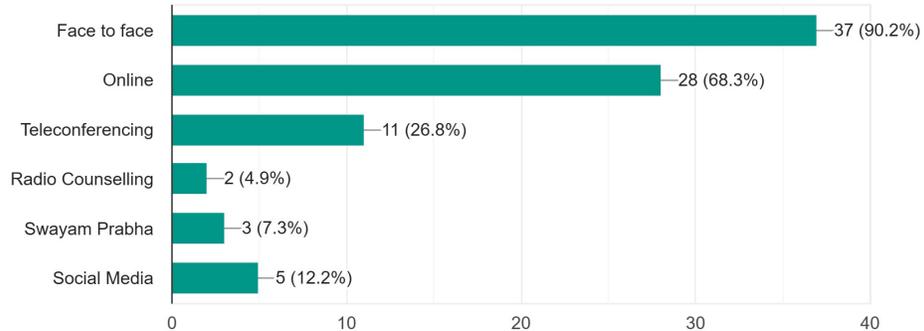
#### Statement wise feedback

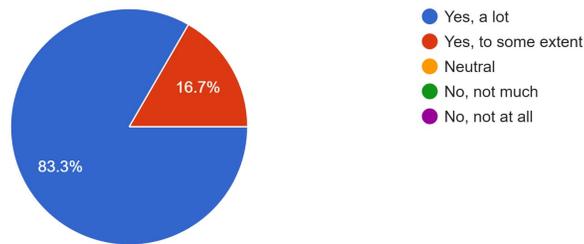
**Fig 5: Bar graph for mode of academic counselling is more useful**

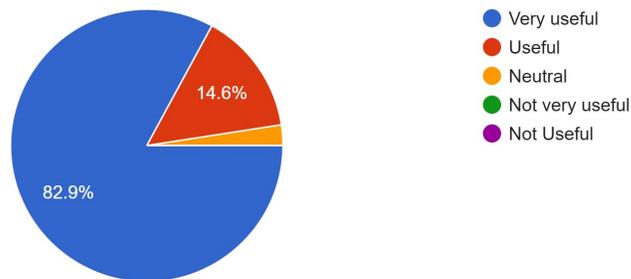
**Fig 6: Pie-chart for opinion on academic counselling sessions provide opportunities for interaction and discussion**

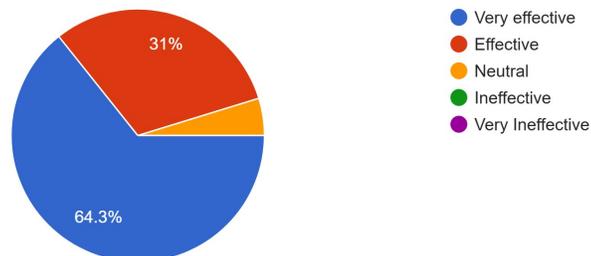
**Fig 7: Pie-chart for opinion on useful are academic counselling sessions in enhancing learners' subject knowledge and clarifying their doubts**

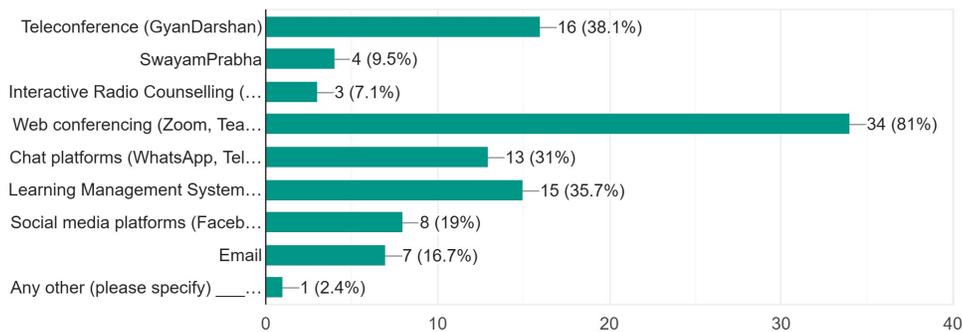
**Fig 8: Pie-chart for opinion on the ICT integration is more effective in the teaching-learning process**

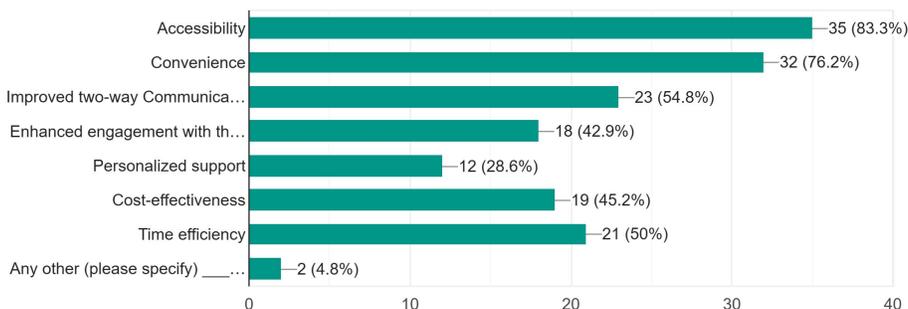
**Fig 9: Bar diagram for opinion on which ICT tool(s) is more effective for academic counselling in your subject in ODL**

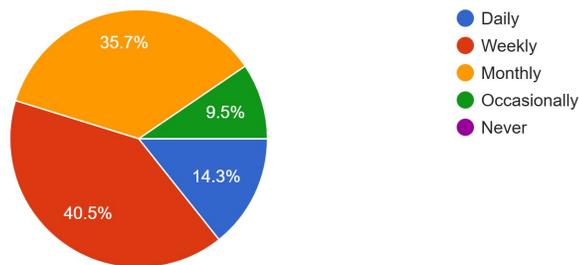


**Fig 10: Bar diagram for opinion on benefits of using ICT in academic counselling in your subject**
