9. Critically evaluate the application of IHL to the ethnic conflict in Sri Lanka.
10. Discuss the relevance of education of IHL in South Asia.
11. Explain the role of National Red Cross Committees in the implementation of IHL.

12. Who are military advisers ? Discuss their role in the implementation of IHL.
