1. Design and implement a website/web application having three web pages, each having the following layout :

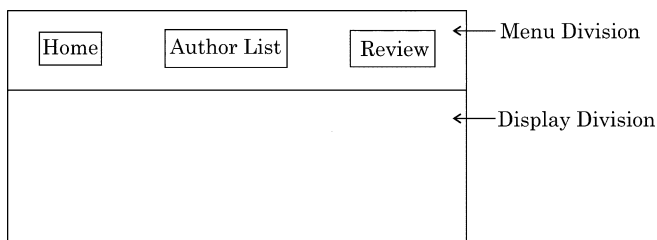


Figure 1 : Layout of the Web pages

Create three web pages having the same “Menu Division”. The links in “Menu Division” are as follows :

Home	It is a link to Home page.
Author List	It is a link to list of Authors that is generated using a JSP program and a database.
Review	It is a link to a page which contains the form to review on article of an author.

The “Display Division” of the three pages should be as per the following description :

- (a) Home page should display a message “Welcome to Author World” and display the address and phone number in tabular format.

- (b) Create a database Author consisting of a single relation author_list (id, name, article_id), where id and article_id forms the composite key. Enter about 5 records in this table. Write a JSP program that queries the database and displays the results of the query in the “Display Division” as shown below :
