1. Design and implement a website/web application having three web pages. All the three web pages should have the following layout :




Figure 1 : Layout of the Web pages

The “Menu Division” should be the same in all the three web pages. The **Home** is a link to the home page. **Programme** is a link to a page that is created by a JSP program and a database. The **Query** is a link to an HTML page, which may be used to ask a query.

The “Content Division” of the three pages should be as per the following description :

- (a) The home page should display the message “Welcome to ABC University”. It should also display the university address and contact person details in a tabular format. 6
- (b) The Programme page should be created using a JSP program, which queries a database “university” having a single

table programme (code, title, duration, eligibility). You should create the database and enter about 5 records in this database. The JSP program should query the database and the result of this query should be displayed in the “Content Division” of programme page as shown below :

and NOT to verify or process the form),
