(c) Discuss any *four* principles of building an engaging Mathematics classroom, giving an example for each principle that shows how the principle will be implemented while teaching concepts of Mathematics.

2. (a) Define the term 'environment', its different aspects and the interaction among components of the environment.

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(b) Explain any *two* strategies for developing values in children, giving an example for each strategy.

- (c) What is the significance of development of oral language during early primary years?
- (d) Explain giving examples, how is oral language typically treated in the classroom.
- 3. (a) What is a Unit Plan ? Identify a topic/theme of a Unit Plan of your choice. With respect to this topic/theme, make a Unit Plan stating the following :

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(i) The duration of the Unit Plan and justification for the duration.

- (ii) The subtopics/subthemes you will identify within the overall theme/topic.
- (iii) The concepts, values and skills you will foster in the children through the Unit Plan.
- (iv) The methods of teaching, you will use to foster the concepts, skills and values.

You can use a table or a diagram to support your answer.

(b) Describe the typical setup of a Maths classroom. Discuss the constructivist approach of teaching Mathematics. How does it differ from typical teaching methods?
