- 5. "Voss' journey is a quest for determining the nature of individual identity in a strange land." Discuss.
- 6. Examine how the poem 'Coming to' by Ed Tiang Hong re-defines Australian identity.
- 7. "Exile and alienation are the central themes of *Remembering Babylon*." Comment.
- 8. Consider the play *The Removalists* as a critique of Australian society.
