Dr. Pankaj Khanna, Deputy Director from P&DD was present to assist the Committee.

At the outset, the Member Secretary welcomed the Chairman, Member(s), and Special Invitee(s) to the 63rd Meeting of the Academic Programme Committee (APC) and requested the Chair for opening remarks.

The Chairman then asked Member Secretary to present the agenda items.

The Member Secretary thereafter presented the agenda items. He briefed that this meeting agenda contains 24-items. There are 9-Programme Proposal Forms (PPF), 11-Programme Launch Approval Forms (PLAF), and 4 items on online and swayam programmes. He briefed that the Planning Division has also received the target dates of academic programmes to be launched by the School of Studies and these have been placed with the action taken reports.

- A.P.C. 63.1 To confirm the Minutes of the 62nd Meeting of the Academic Programme Committee held on 16th December 2021 and Action Taken Reports (ATRs).
