## Minutes of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Research Council

Dr. Bharat Bhushan, Deputy Director attended the meeting to facilitate the proceedings.

Prof. Ruth Manorama did not attend the meeting as she had completed her term as member of the Board of Management.

Dr. P. Prakash, former Pro Vice Chancellor did not attend the meeting since he joined back UGC.

The Meeting began with welcome by the Chairman who introduced the new members to the Research Council. The Chairman, in his introductory remarks, highlighted the significance of research programmes for the University. The Chairman said that the last meeting of the Research Council was held on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2013 and it took a lot of time to have this meeting because IGNOU's new Ordinance on Research Degree Programmes is under submission to MHRD for the Visitor's assent. Since the University is waiting for the approval from the Ministry, the present meeting was convened after a considerable gap. The Chairman expressed the importance of offering Research Degree Programmes by the University, which are presently on hold. He reiterated that the university is constantly following up the issue of the approval of the revised Ordinance. The Chairman also informed the Council about the positive efforts taken by the Ministry. The Chairman has presented the university's stand on its Research Programmes as per provisions contained in Section 5.1 (i), Section 5.1 (v), Section 5.1 (xiv) of the IGNOU Act.

IGNOU has 549 staff members including more than 100 Professors with rich experience in teaching and research. The Chairman emphasized that the future of higher education lies with the ODL system which is not only cost effective but also has a wider reach in India. The spread of higher education in tune to our requirements is possible only through the ODL system. For the promotion of Discipline-based and Systemic research, the basic requirement of teaching and research is always emphasized. Further, the Chairman expressed concern that if the university does not carry on with its Research Programmes, the linkages with new generation will also be affected adversely. All the members of Research Council have agreed to the concerns of Chairperson regarding M.Phil/Ph.D Programmes.

The Chairman invited the members of the Research Council to give inputs on the New Education Policy on ODL system and On-line learning, for which the responsibility has been assigned to the university by MHRD. Further, the Chairman informed that under the Direct Benefit Scheme for SC/ST students, the Government of India has made budgetary provisions. The Planning Division of the University is developing a scheme to implement the same in IGNOU. The Chairman also assured the Council that necessary steps would be taken to facilitate the researchers who are not getting any financial assistance from any other funding agencies. The Members of the Research Council have endorsed the views of the Chairman and requested to him to initiate appropriate actions in this regard.

The Chairman asked Prof. M.S. Nathawat, Member Secretary of Research Council to present the Agenda Items. The Meeting was informed by Prof. M.S. Nathawat that Agenda Items were organized in conformity with the decision of the Research Council taken in its 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting.

There was a discussion on the issue of Clause 4.4 of the Research Ordinance related to research supervision for Research Degree Programme which stipulate that "at any time, a Supervisor cannot guide more than 4/5 students out of whom 2/3 students may be MPhil, and not more than 2 PhD students". One of the Member of RC invited the attention of the Council about the decision taken in the 9 <sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Research Council where it was decided that Clause 4.4 of the Ordinance on Research Degree

	Programme be amended and it was decided that number should be increased to 6 with a provision that in case of joint supervision the number would be increased proportionately (e.g., if a student is supervised by the two supervisors, the load of each supervisor would be counted as ½; thus a supervisor can guide 6-12 PhD students at a time depending upon the fact that the candidates are under sole or joint supervision) and that the Clause 4.4 be amended suitably. Accordingly, on the line of the above decision the Research Unit has also came out with a Circular vide IG/RU/2011/205 dated 5 <sup>th</sup> May 2011 to notify this decision. The Council asked the research unit to act accordingly.

RC 22.4.1	The BOM (Item 121.16.6) directed the Research Council to have a fresh look at the Research Degree Programme of IGNOU in terms of its quality and feasibility where the Board resolved that the matter may be referred back to Research Council of IGNOU to have a fresh look at the Research Degree Programmes in terms of its

RC 22.4.2	Members deliberated on the issue of Research Degree Programmes of the University.  Members have said that IGNOU is maintaining quality in its M.Phil/Ph.D Programmes.  They are conducting entrance test and course work also.
RC 22.4.3	The Council is satisfied about the quality of M.Phil/Ph.D works in the university. It was suggested that efforts be made to restart the M.Phil/Ph.D. Programmes at the earliest.
RC 22.5 Research Unit	Consideration the issues of eligibility criteria regarding students admitted to M.Phil/Ph.D
RC 22.5.1	A Committee was constituted by the Vice Chancellor of IGNOU to examine the issue of eligibility criteria laid out as per Clause 3.2(i) of the IGNOU Ordinance on Research Degree Programmes, 2008 in respect of students who got admitted in Research Degree Programmes for the award of PhD/MPhil degree in various disciplines in various School of Studies in the past with the scores less than 55% marks in general category and less than 50% marks in SC/ST category.

The Chairman of this Committee informed the Council that these are the observations of the committee. The Chairman of the Committee also informed that learner should not be put to any disadvantage.
RC 22.5.3	After the detail deliberations, the Council decided to request the Committee to come out with specific recommendations.
RC 22.6 Research Unit	Consideration the issues related to liquidation of centres.
RC 22.6.1	The University has been offering academic programmes in research i.e. PhD/MPhil through its different School of Studies. In the past, these programmes were also housed in various centres i.e. Centre for Corporate Education, Training and Consultancy (CCETC), Centre for Paramedical Sciences (CPMS), Centre for Extension Education (CEE), Advance Centre for Informatics and Innovation Learning (ACIIL) and Centre for Traditional Knowledge Systems (CTKS) and were offering Research Degree Programmes leading to award of MPhil/PhD in the past, as their own academic programme. These centres were expected to constitute School Board like Academic Committees but this could not happen as there was a requirement of amendments in the statute 10 A of the University statute to make the proposal operational. The academic programmes offered from the centres in the backdrop of above decisions suffered lacuna of not having necessary statutory

	sanction. Subsequently, it was decided to liquidate these centres (BOM 118.18.2) by re-locating them in Schools keeping in view the disciplines in existing Schools of the University. There are number of research students admitted in these centres are facing hardship.
	A Committee was constituted by the Vice Chancellor of IGNOU to consider issues related to liquidation of centres and relocation of the same in various Schools of Studies. This committee has given the following recommendations:-
	1 To constitute Area Committee as per the provisions available under the Clause 2.4 and Clause 2.5 of the Research Ordinance.
	2 Asked RU to check about the course work has been allotted to any of the students under consideration
	The Director, RU informed the Council that most of the students were enrolled during 2009-10 academic year and their maximum period of duration is also ending.
