
The 30th Meeting of the Research Council was held on 24th December 2021 in a Blended mode. The following members attended the meeting both in offline and online mode:

Dr Satish Gaikwad, Asst. Director, Research Unit, IGNOU was present to assist in the proceedings of the Research Council.

At the outset, Prof. Nageshwar Rao, Vice Chancellor, IGNOU and Chairperson, Research Council, welcomed Prof. S. S. Sarkar, Vice-Chancellor, NSOU, Kolkatta and Dr.Anamika Shukla, Associate Professor, SOH, IGNOU as the new members of the Research Council and acknowledged the contribution of the outgoing members Dr. P. Prakash former VC, SRM University and Dr. S. K. Palit, Associate Professor, SOCE in the deliberations of the Research Council. In his initial remarks, the Chairperson gave a brief account of the activities related to PhD Admissions for July, 2021 session. He apprised the Committee about the advertisement for admission to Ph D programme in 23 disciplines and the entrance examination to be conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) in January 2022. The Chairperson shared with the committee about the number of fellowship holders pursuing Research Degree programmes in the University funded by different funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, ICCR, DST etc. He also explained about the IGNOU Research fellowship scheme under which financial assistance is provided to thirty eligible research scholars every year on the basis of merit.

Thereafter, the Chairperson requested the Director (I/c), Research Unit and Member Secretary of the Research Council to present the Agenda. The agenda was presented as under:

RC	The Research Council confirmed the Minutes of the 21st Meeting of the Research Council Standing

RC 30.3	To Consider approval of Standard Operating procedure (SOP) for processing Fellowships awarded by different Funding Agencies.
RC	The agenda was presented by the Member Secretary in detail. The Member Secretary informed the
30.3.1	Committee about the rationale of drafting a SOP for processing Fellowships. She apprised the
	members that the Research Unit deals with the processing of doctoral and post-doctoral
	fellowships/scholarships of all most 311 scholars. Out of the total number of scholarship holders,
	more than 200 Fellowships are funded by UGC, ICSSR, ICHR, DST, Government of India etc.
	Besides, IGNOU Research Fellowship is given to thirty eligible scholars every year on basis of
	merit that are also processed by Research Unit.
	Underlining the rationale behind drafting a SOP, she said that while processing the documents of
	the fellowships, often there are discrepancies at the level of the scholars/Schools/Finance which
	eventually create difficulty in processing. Besides, the funding agencies also make intermittent
	amendments in the norms for which a regular tuning with the norms becomes important. She also
	informed the Committee about the observations of Funding Agencies with regard to
	noncompliance of norms by fellowship holders in certain cases. Therefore, it was felt necessary to
	lay down a comprehensive operating procedure that would be beneficial for processing the
	fellowships smoothly at all levels. The SOP was drafted by the Research Unit under the
	supervision of a committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor which was also circulated amongst
	the schools of studies seeking suggestions/ inputs, she informed. The suggestions received were
	duly incorporated before finalizing the SOP.



RC 30.3.2	The Research Council appreciated the initiative of the University in streamlining the processing of
30.3.2	fellowships. The Research Council considered and approved the Standard Operating Procedure
	(SOP) for processing Fellowships awarded by different Funding Agencies (Annexure-30.3.1)

RC 30.4 To Consider allocation of Research Topics/Supervisor to the PhD students in various Disciplines.

RC 30.4.1 The Member Secretary presented the agenda in detail. RC 30.4.2

The Research Council noted the delay pertaining to approval of research topics in case of Ms.Mawi Ngaih Lian and Ms.Iram Sabha at Sl no 4 and 9 and viewed that the concerned schools should take appropriate measures to ensure timely allotment of research topics / supervisors, in order to facilitate the research scholars and asked the Research Unit to send advisory to Schools in this regard. The Research Council approved the research topics and supervisors of all the research scholars including Ms.Mawi Ngaih Lian and Ms.Iram Sabha.

RC 30.5 To Consider approval of the Research Topics resubmitted by School of Education in respect of Ms. Riva Banerjee and Ms.PoojaTomar,PhD scholars of Education.

RC 30.5.1

The agenda was presented by the Member Secretary in detail. The Member Secretary explained the members about the Research topics of the following two Research scholars Ms.Riya Banerjee and Ms.Pooja Tomar, PhD scholars of Education which were referred back to the School for review and resubmission by the RCSC in its 21st meeting held on 26th August, 2021 with the observation that that the School of Education should have identified more relevant research problems focusing more on teaching-learning, pedagogy, learning outcomes, technological interventions, case studies etc and the type of research problems as have been allocated should be avoided. The Committee referred back the research topics to SOE for review and resubmission.

The member secretary informed the Committee about the justification given by the DRC in resubmitting the same topics thatConsidering the work that the scholars have already put into the topic and the relevance of the topics for the discipline of educational studies, the members reiterated the earlier decision taken by the DRC and re-recommended the topics with respect to (a) Ms.Riya Banerjee& (b) Ms. Pooja Tomar.

It was further considered by the members of the DRC that the suggestions made by RCSC shall be kept in mind before finalizing the topics in future.

RC 30.5.2

The Research Council noted the observation of the RCSC and also the justification given by the DRC as recommended by the School Board, SOE. The council expressed concern over the fact that the school had not taken cognizance of the observations of the RCSC and had resubmitted the topics without any review. The Council took a serious view and decided to authorize Prof. R. P. Das, Pro-Vice Chancellor to look into the matter and resolve the issue in a time bound manner so that the students should not face any further delay in finalization of their research topics.

RC 30.6

To Consider approval of Dr. Tahir Siddiqui, Asst Prof, SOPVA as Research Supervisor in the Discipline of Performing and Visual Arts to guide Research Scholars

RC 30.6.1

The agenda was presented by the Member Secretary in detail. The Member Secretary explained that the 20th RCSC held on 19thAugust, 2020 had not considered Dr. Tahir Siddiqui, Assistant Professor, SOPVA to be a Research supervisor on the ground of lack of publications required as per UGC norms. However, the DRC, and the School Board, SOPVA had recommended him to be a research supervisor subsequently on the basis of his publications complying to the norms of UGC Regulations.



The Research Council noted the recommendations of the School on the basis of his publications and approved the name of Tahir Siddiqui, Assistant Professor, SOPVA as Research Supervisor as recommended by the DRC and the School Board.

		The agenda was presented by the member secretary in detail. She explained the Committee about			
the procedure of evaluation of Thesis as per Cl 9.7 of UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for					
Award of M Phil/ Ph D Degree) Regulations 2016which states that "The thesis submitted by a Research					
	Scholar shall be evaluated by his /her Research Supervisor and at least two external examiners who are not				
	in the employment of the University, of whom one examiner may be from outside the country, nominated by the				
	Vice Chancellor. The name of the external examiners included in the panel of evaluators will be placed by the				
	Chairperson in the meeting of the School Board for consideration and approval.				
	The members were informed that as per the above mentioned cl of UGC (Minimum Standards and				
	-				
	Procedure for Award of M Phil/ Ph D Degree) Regulations 2016 all the supervisors were submitting				
	reports, however the formats used by them is not standardized as the same was not specifically				
	mentioned in the Ph D guidelines resulting confusion at times. Further remuneration for evaluation				
	was being paid only to external supervisors for evaluation of thesis and viva voce. As per existing				
	practice payment for evaluation of thesis and VIVA was being made by the Research Unit and the				
	concerned Schools respectively.				
	The matter was deliberated at length. The committee viewed that since the internal supervisor was				
	required to evaluate the thesis as per the Regulations, the procedure of evaluation and payment of				
	remuneration in case of the internal supervisor as one of the evaluators should be made at par with				
	the external evaluators.				
	The Committee resolved that the internal supervisor will henceforward submit the report of the				
	evaluation in the same format as prescribed by the University for external evaluators. The Council				
	further resolved that the internal supervisor will be paid remuneration for evaluation of Thesis and				



VIVA at par with the external evaluators by the Research Unit and the School respectively. However, the remuneration to internal supervisors will be paid from the date of notification of the decision.
