Dr. Bijayalaxmi Mishra, Deputy Director and Dr. Satish Gaikawad, Assistant Director, Research Unit were present to assist in the RCSC proceedings.

At the outset the Chairperson welcomed Prof. Ravindra Ramachandra Kanhere Pro Vice Chancellor, IGNOU and other members of the newly constituted Research Council Standing Committee(RCSC). Subsequently, he requested Director, Research Unit and Member-Convener of the RCSC to present the Agenda Items.

The Director, Research Unit informed the Members that the major part of the admission process to MPhil/ PhD programmes for July 2019 session in 18 Disciplines (PhD in Bio-Chemistry, Chemistry, Commerce, Education, English, Environmental Science, Fine Arts, Geology, Gender and Development Studies, Hindi, Journalism and Mass Communication, Management, Music, Rural Development, Statistics, Social Work, Translation Studiesand Women's Studies and MPhil in Chemistry, Commerce, Journalism and Mass Communication and Translation Studies) including conduct of Entrance Test, Interviews, and recommendations of the selected candidates by the respective DRCs/ School Boards have been completed within a span of two months. The Members appreciated the efforts of the Research Unit for the systematic accomplishment of the entire process. The Director (RU) shared with the members the details on the number of seats advertised and final selection of candidates, category-wise, adding that the stipulated reservation of seats has been nearly achieved in the selection process. He informed the members that out of 182 (22 MPhil+ 160)

PhD) seats advertised, 98(07 MPhil + 91PhD) candidates in total were selected in different disciplines. The selection of the candidates were done strictly as per the UGC Regulations for conduct of Research Programmes and judged in terms of candidates' Entrance Test (70% weightage), Interview (30% weightage). The breakup of the selected candidates, Discipline-wise as recommended by the respective DRCs/ School Boards is as follows:

To Consider and approve/review of allotment of Research Supervisors having less than three years to superannuate

RCSC 19.3.1

The members were informed about the decision of the 26th RC regarding review of allocation of research supervisors that the faculty members having less than three years to superannuate shall not be allotted research scholars as Research Supervisors (RC.26.7.2). The RC also decided that in case of the research students who have already been allocated supervisors having less than three years to superannuate, may be referred to the concerned Disciplines for re-consideration in the light of RC resolution. Accordingly, the RU communicated to the concerned Disciplines/Schools regarding the decision of the RC and to take necessary action. In response some of the Schools had given their feedback.

The Members deliberated on the matter and suggested that the existing supervisors having less than three years to superannuate shall continue to supervise and complete supervision before his/her superannuation. If the DRC feels that the work will not be completed, then the necessary arrangement for reallocating supervisor at least 90 days prior to superannuation of the concerned supervisor may be done so that the research scholar is not at disadvantage.

The university resources are utilized for the conduct of Research Degree Programmes facilitating the research scholars where as a student seeking extension in maximum duration, extension fee is charged from the student proportionately for the period of extension. It is, therefore, logical that the fee should be charged for the period spent by the student for completing the MPhil/PhD Programmes. The members also noted that the proposal for charging fees for the total period had been approved by the 18th RCSC in principle. However, the Finance Committee while considering the proposal to increase the fees of Research Degree programmes only recommended 20% increase in fees and there was no decision on the duration for which fee should be charged. |
