

Minutes of the Twenty Second Meeting of Research Council Standing Committee (RCSC), IGNOU held on 13th May, 2022 at 12.30 PM in the Board Room, VCO.

The Twenty Second Meeting of the Research Council Standing Committee was conducted on 13th May 2022, at 12.30 PM in the Board Room, VCO. The Meeting was attended by the following members:

The Meeting started with Prof Nageshwar Rao, Vice Chancellor and Chairperson, RCSC welcoming the members of the RCSC. He welcomed Prof M Meena, PVC as a special invitee to the RCSC who has been entrusted with the supervision of the Research Unit. Speaking briefly on the PhD admission for the July 2021 session, he apprised the members about the Ph D admission process in the July 2020 session which got delayed due to the COVID 19 Pandemic and resultant delay in the subsequent sessions. Apprising the members about the number of candidates appeared for the entrance test for admission to Ph D Programme in July 2021 session, he said that the response was huge with 9196 candidates appearing in the test out of which 3398 candidates (37%) qualified. He then requested the member secretary to present the agenda. The agenda were presented as under:

RCSC 22.1	To Consider approval of recommended candidates in various Disciplines for Admission to PhD Programmes, July 2021 session.



22.1.1	<p>The member Secretary presented the Agenda in detail. She apprised the members that the University advertised for admission to PhD programme for July 2021 session in twenty three disciplines; Anthropology, Political Science, Chemistry, Geology, Life Sciences, Mathematics, Management, Commerce, Education, Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Urdu, Computer Science, Law, Nursing, Inter Disciplinary and Trans Disciplinary Studies, Environmental Science, Tourism Studies, Translation Studies, Vocational Education, Women's Studies and Child Development.</p> <p>She further informed that the National Testing Agency (NTA) conducted the Entrance Test on 24th February, 2022 and the result was declared by the NTA on 24th March, 2022. Result was communicated to all Disciplines/ Schools along with the instructions to conduct the Interviews of the shortlisted candidates and to submit the final recommended candidates to Research Unit by 30th April 2022. Out of twenty three Disciplines, Seventeen (17) disciplines had submitted the final list of candidates whereas six disciplines. The rest six disciplines (Child Development, Nursing, Computer Science, Commerce, Management and Education) had not sent the list of recommended candidates.</p> <p>Deliberating on the matter, the Committee expressed its displeasure with regard to the delay in finalization of the result of six Disciplines (Child Development, Nursing, Computer Science, Commerce, Management and Education) for admission to PhD programme. After deliberating on the recommended list of candidates by the disciplines including the waitlisted candidates, the members observed that some of the disciplines like Anthropology, Women's Studies, English and Sanskrit had recommended candidates, which needed a relook particularly concerning the large number of waitlisted candidates in English and Sanskrit. The Committee also observed that in case of Anthropology, two waitlisted candidates, as recommended by the DRC and School Board could have been considered under selected category in order of merit, as the discipline had projected five vacancies. In women's Studies, the Committee noted that the minutes of DRC and School Board did not mention about the reasons for not filling up vacant seats in some categories. In case of Sanskrit discipline, the committee was of the view that all the faculty members of Sanskrit being new, large intake of research students might hamper the quality of teaching and supervision and may result in unmanageable workload as the faculty members have other programmes to attend to.</p>

RCSC 22.3	To Consider the issue pertaining to the evaluation of thesis i.r.o. Ms. Rucche Sharrma, Enrl. No. 100165569, PhD scholar in Computer Science, SOCIS.				
RCSC 22.3.1	<p>The agenda was presented in detail by the Member Secretary. She explained the members that Ms. Rucche Sharrma was registered in the Discipline of Computer Sciences (SOCIS), in 2010 and submitted her thesis to the Research Unit in July, 2016 for evaluation. She was also granted extension of one year beyond the stipulated period of seven years (being a female candidate, she availed two years extra time for completion of Ph.D). Ms. Rucche Sharrma was working under the supervision of external supervisor, Dr Dr Amit Gupta, Head Department of Management, Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Technology (affiliated to GGS Indraprastha University), Rohini, New Delhi. She further apprised the members that as per earlier norms, the Ph.D. thesis was being evaluated by three external evaluators and in case of Ms. Rucche Sharrma, out of three external evaluators, two evaluators recommended the thesis for the award of Ph.D. degree where as one of the evaluators rejected the thesis.</p> <p>She further stated that as per the Clause 23 of Comprehensive Guidelines of 2012 under which</p>				

	the candidate was being governed stated “If one of the examiners does not recommend the thesis for the award of a Ph.D. degree, the thesis shall be referred to another examiner for independent evaluation. If the fourth examiner recommends the thesis for the award, the viva voce examination shall be organized by the Director of the School. However, if this examiner also rejects the thesis, the thesis shall be rejected by the University”. Accordingly, after being rejected by one of the evaluators, the thesis of Ms. Rucche Sharrma was sent to the fourth examiner, who also referred back the thesis suggesting modifications and corrections. The research scholar and the supervisor of the Scholar were communicated through the Director, SOCIS about the suggestions / modifications to be incorporated. After a gap of one year, the scholar resubmitted the revised Thesis certified by the Supervisor. However, the fourth examiner referred back the thesis for the second time stating that “ <i>the thesis has no significant improvement. Plagiarism report and publication requirements have also not been specified. Publications are in 2012 and 2015, which indicate 7 years after publications the thesis is being submitted</i> ”. Further, he has also stated that “ <i>the revised thesis may be sent to other examiners for judicious evaluation</i> ”.

RCSC 22.7.1	<p>The Member Secretary presented the agenda in detail. She informed the members that Shri Manoj Kumar Patel bearing enrollment no. 149500013 was admitted to PhD programme in Law. However he could not complete his PhD during the stipulated period and was granted extension of six months by the Competent Authority. Shri Patel also represented for change of supervisor citing various reasons. Thereafter he filed a writ petition WP (C) No 39705/2021 in the High Court of Odisha praying for more time to complete his Ph D work and to change his supervisor. By this time Prof. K. Elumalai, the supervisor of Shri Patel had superannuated. The Hon’ble High Court granted relief to the Petitioner, Mr Patel to make representation before the authority for redressal of his grievance. Consequent upon the court order, the Grievance Committee for Research Scholars was convened on 7th January 2022 which recommended SOL to convene the DRC for allocating another supervisor to Sh Manoj Kumar Patel. The DRC allocated Dr Mansi Sharma who consented to supervise Sh. Manoj Kumar Patel as per the details mentioned as under: The Grievance Committee also urged the Research scholar to complete the research work in a time bound manner.
