#### **Rules & Regulations**

### Internal Credit Transfer from MP/MPB/PGDFM/PGDMM/PGDHRM/PGDOM/PGDFMP)(Old syllabus) to Master of Business Administration (Banking and Finance) (MBF)(Revised Syllabus)

- (i) Credit transfer would be granted for courses under revised syllabus as per Credit transfer scheme enclosed as page no. 4 & 5
- (ii) Under no circumstances students will be allowed to opt more than the permissible credits in a given semester.
- (iii) Students are required to pay credit transfer through on-line mode via miscellaneous fee account available at IGNOU website (a receipt of payment is to be attached with credit transfer form) or by way of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'IGNOU' payable at New Delhi.
- (iv) The students have to pay the prescribed fee of Internal Credit Transfer and Change of Course separately.
- Although credit transfer for all the eligible courses (against successfully completed courses (v) MP/MPB/PGDFM/PGDMM/PGDHRM/PGDOM/PGDFMP)(Old syllabus)), irrespective of the semester(s) in which these are offered, would be granted as per credit transfer scheme referred to in clause (i) above, yet the students will pursue the left-over courses in the revised syllabus.

### **Rules & Regulations**

### Change of Course from MP/MPB Old syllabus) to Master of Business Administration (Banking and Finance ) (MBF)(Revised Syllabus)

- 1. Under no circumstances student will be allowed to opt more than the maximum credits permissible for a given semester.
- 2. If the dates of counseling and/or practical classes clash by way of merging the left over courses of first/second/third/fourth semester, students are required to **apply for repeat/missed practical(s)**to the Regional Centre concerned **,in the next cycle/session,** as per University rules.
- 3. Students are required to pay the change of course fee @ Rs.2000/- for 4 Credits through on-line mode via miscellaneous fee account available at IGNOU website (a receipt of payment is to be attached with change of course form) or by way of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'IGNOU' payable at New Delhi.
- 4. Please post this filled up Change of Course Form along with Demand Draft/Online payment Ref. No.: To: Registrar, SRD, Block 3, IGNOU, Maidan Garhi, New Delhi 110068.
- 5. The students have to pay the prescribed fee of Internal Credit Transfer and Change of Course separately.
- 6. Students would be allowed to change the courses registered for the 1st semester under new Enrolment No., against the left over courses of 2nd and/or 3rd semester/or 4<sup>th</sup> Semester, **subject to maximum of 28 credits** in a given semester, by remitting the prescribed fee as per current University norms.
- 7. Change of course is permitted in the 1st year; provided the **left-over courses do not exceed 28 credits**. If the left-over courses exceed 28 credits, then the students can apply for change of course when they re-register for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester courses in their New Enrollment Number.
