- Agenda No. To consider and approve the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and SB.43.2 Programme Project Report (PPR) of Diploma in Agriculture as per UGC Guidelines.
- Prof. S. K. Yadav, Programme Coordinator, presented this agenda item and explained the salient features of the Diploma in Agriculture programme. The Programme Development Form (PDF) of this programme was approved by the Academic Council in its 75<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18.11.2020 vide item no. 75.7.2. As per the university norms programme structure of 32 credits was approved by the Academic Council. As per the latest UGC guidelines, the Diploma programme should be of 40 credits. Accordingly, an Expert Group meeting was convened on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2023 and the syllabus of the Diploma in Agriculture was revised with increase in credit load from 32 to 40 credits.

This programme will be of a total of 40 credits with 8 theory courses. The minimum eligibility for the programme shall be 12<sup>th</sup> pass out in any discipline. The target groups of this programme are youth and prospective farmers, agriculture and input dealers, farmers and farm women. The duration of the programme will be a minimum of one year and a maximum of three years. The programme will be offered in English at launch and later on will be translated in Hindi, and other regional languages. For learners' assessment for award of Diploma, 30% weightage is given to continuous assessment and 70% to Term End Examination.

The detailed discussions were held regarding the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and the Programme Project Report (PPR) of the Diploma in Agriculture programme.

- SB.43.2.2 The School Board approved the revised Programme Development Form (PDF) and the Programme Project Report (PPR) of Diploma in Agriculture (Appendix-2).
- Agenda No. To consider and approve the Programme Development Form (PDF) and SB.43.3 Programme Project Report (PPR) of the "Diploma in Agricultural Cost Management".
- The Programme Coordinator, Dr. P. K. Jain, presented this agenda item and informed SB.43.3.1 the School Board members that an MoU has been signed with the Institute of Cost Accountants of India (ICMAI) on 24th April 2023, to jointly develop the Diploma in Agricultural Cost Management programme. In this regard, the Expert Group meetings held on 20th July 2022 and 13th Jan.'23 made the detailed deliberations on the need, title, and objectives of programme, target group, eligibility for enrolment (Minimum qualification) and programme structure (credits load and courses). The programme will be of a total of 40 credits with 6 theory courses. The minimum eligibility for the programme shall be 12th pass out in any discipline. The target groups of this programme Small and medium entrepreneurs and NGO Urban/Rural Youth; functionaries/trainers; and Progressive farmers. The duration of the programme will be a minimum of one year and a maximum of three years. For learners' assessment for award of Diploma, 30% weightage is given to continuous assessment and 70% to Term End Examination.

The Board suggested that the programme may be launched from January, 2024 session.

- SB.43.6.1 Prof. S. K. Yadav presented this agenda item and informed to the School Board members that the NAAC started the accreditation of the open and distance learning institutions in 2020 and our University has been accorded with A++ grade by the NAAC in 2021. IGNOU is the first higher educational institute in the open distance learning (ODL) mode to be accredited A++.

As per the guidelines for NAAC accreditation, Centre for Internal Quality Assurance (CIQA) of University obtains feedback from the learners, subject experts, teaching and non-teaching staff and other stakeholders every year not only to improve the development and delivery of its Open and Distance Learning (ODL) and online programmes, but also improve and sustain the quality of the system as a whole. The University has prepared the tool for getting feedback from different stakeholders including the subject experts.

- Agenda No. To consider and approve the name of experts for unit-writing and editing for SB.43.8 Diploma in Agriculture.
- SB.43.8.1 The Programme Coordinator presented this agenda item and informed that the School is developing a Diploma in Agriculture programme for imparting entrepreneurial skills among various stakeholders of agriculture and allied sectors. An Expert Group meeting was convened on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2023 to revise the syllabus of the Diploma in Agriculture to increase the credit load from 32 to 40 credits. The experts have also finalized the list of unit writers and editors for the Diploma in Agriculture.
- SB.43.8.2 The School Board approved the name of experts for unit-writing and editing for Diploma in Agriculture <u>Appendix-5</u>.
- Agenda No. To consider and approve the Entrance Test results for admission to PhD in Dairy SB.43.9 Science & Technology (PHDDR) programme for the July 2022 session.
- SB.43.9.1 The Programme Coordinator presented this agenda item and informed the members that the Entrance Test for admission to the PhD in Dairy Science & Technology (PHDDR) programme for July 2022 session was conducted by the University on 8th January 2023 against total vacancies advertised are 04 (GEN-03 & OBC-01). The result of the Entrance test has been declared by SED, IGNOU, on 23.5.2023 and received from the Research Unit. The School has to conduct the interview of candidates who have qualified the minimum score/requirements and prepare the merit list for admission. As per the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of MPhil/PhD Degree) (2nd Amendment) Regulations, 2018, "the General Candidates securing 50% marks and SC/ST/OBC(NC)/PWD/EWS candidates securing 45% marks in the Entrance Test shall be shortlisted for Interview in order of merit, subject to maximum limit of 5 times of the vacant seats".

An agenda item for recommendation of the PhD entrance test results for admission to PHDDR programme was considered by the DRC members and the DRC recommended that since no candidate has secured the minimum passing marks in the entrance test; none of the candidates are eligible for the interview. Keeping the above in view, no student will be admitted in the PHDDR programme for July 2022 session.

The minutes of the DRC meeting held through circulation mode were submitted to the School Board (<u>Appendix-6</u>) for consideration and approval.

SB.43.9.2 The School Board approved Entrance Test results for admission to PhD in Dairy Science & Technology (PHDDR) programme for the July 2022 session.
